2005 has been a very productive year for the Golf Association of Ontario. The Board of Directors and our staff have worked diligently to improve and grow the services and programs we offer to amateur golfers in Ontario. We have been very fortunate to have retained and to have expanded the list of our corporate sponsors, without whose assistance our programs would suffer. Our major partner, Investors Group along with Beck's Non-Alcoholic Beer, Baka Wireless, Bushnell, Grey Power Insurance, Moore's Clothing, Ashworth,

Titleist, Footjoy, Ultimate Golf Vacations and Davey Tree have all contributed to the growth and ongoing success of our many programs. Along with these corporate sponsors the Government of Ontario has also been a key contributor to our funding through the awarding of various government grants. The GAO appreciates the support we receive from all of our partners, as together we invest in the golfing community throughout Ontario.

Early in the year, at the annual Ontario Golf Hall of Fame ceremony, we celebrated the wonderful achievements of four people who have greatly contributed to golf in Ontario. Our heartfelt congratulations go to R. "Stu" Hamilton, the late George "Mac" Frost, Mary Jane Hall, Robert Panasik and their families.

2005 brought a concerted effort to strengthen our District structure as we worked together to reach our members at the grass roots of our organization by offering local programming and competitions while, at the same time, educating our members about the work that we do and why their continued support is so necessary to grow the game of golf in our Province. Several districts are now able to offer programming for both women and men while the other Districts are working to increase their volunteer base to be able to expand their programming to do the same.

As a direct result arising from an strategic planning session held with our District Co-ordinators in the spring, we established that there was a need to meet with our volunteers to communicate and educate them on the various programs and initiatives that we are working on. This fall, with the support of a grant from the Ontario Government's Ministry of Health's Active 2010 Sports Initiatives program, we held a series of 5 Volunteer information workshops throughout the province.

In Northern Ontario we have been able to work with the former Northern Golf Association to unite with the Northern District of the GAO so that we can work towards increasing the number of member clubs in this important part of our province, which can now operate as one cohesive association to enhance the opportunities for all member clubs and players in our Northern District.

Through generous donations and the ongoing support of corporate partners, the GAO has grown its Scholarship fund and the Scholarship Committee is doing exciting work in enabling our talented Junior golfers to apply for and receive much appreciated assistance to continue their post secondary education opportunities.

Under the leadership of our Course Rating and Handicap Committee and department staff, we have initiated several new member services. Including as running an ongoing series of

Handicap Seminars leading to the certification of over 171 Handicap Chairs at our Member Clubs, we continue to be successful in brokering the signed License agreements between Member Clubs and the RCGA. Along with these Handicap Certification Seminars we facilitate Handicap Summits for our certified handicap chairs to meet with their peers to discuss solutions to handicapping issues that arise at the club level. We have also instituted club level Handicap Information Sessions to help members understand the basics of the handicapping system and why it is integral to our game. We continue to build gender neutral course rating teams that are able to rate our Member Clubs and Courses for both men and women on the same rating visits. Our Course Rating volunteers freely give of their time and we owe them our continued gratitude and appreciation for the very important work they do.

Our various Player Development programs at both the District and Provincial level are growing. From grass roots programs at the District level, encouraging and educating higher handicap players to advance their games to the High Performance Development Team, our programs are supporting very positive results. We are grateful for the support of RCGA Regional coaches Dave Woods and Ralph Bauer who give Ontario players access to National level coaching at the Provincial level. Our Ontario competitors have achieved great success at all levels throughout 2005.

Our Public Player program is expanding with more Ontario golfers opting to join our association via this program. With the introduction of our Public Player league in 2005, this program will continue to improve and reach an even greater number of new members.

Our tournaments have grown into world-class events that showcase both our beautiful Member Clubs and the talents of our growing field of competitors. It is exciting that we have to expand the size of the field of our Women's amateur events as more and more women are successfully competing at this level. Our Men's Amateur, held at the prestigious Redtail Golf Club, was just one of our highlights in the 2005 season. With the cooperation and generosity of our Member Clubs we will continue to offer high-level venues to our Ontario players.

Our Rules committee was extremely busy this year not only working with our Rules Officials across the province at our many championships and qualifiers, but also in the training of new Rules Officials. GAO Rules volunteers and staff conducted four RCGA Level 3 Rules seminars over the year.

I would like to thank the Board of Directors, our GAO volunteers and our members who have given so freely of their time to promote amateur golf in Ontario. It has been an amazing and humbling experience to learn about the number of volunteer hours that are so generously donated by many different individuals in our province so that this game we love can continue to grow and reach out to more and more people. It has been my pleasure to work with you. I would also like to take this opportunity to thank our executive director Dave Mills and his staff for all of their guidance and support throughout my term.

### Scholarship Report

This year, with the support of its generous sponsors and partners, the GAO awarded over \$27,000 to 11 deserving student golfers in Ontario.

The GAO has been awarding scholarships to promising young golfers since 1996 and has now awarded over \$150,000. The GAO scholarship program is supported by donations from partners including the Estate of Ken McKenzie, the Christine Fisher Memorial Student Award Fund, Investors Group, Davey Tree, Grey Power Insurance, National Homes, Baka Wireless, Fletcher Leisure Group, Ultimate Golf Vacations, Bushnell, Golfer's Guide and Titleist.

This year the deserving recipients received awards between \$1500 and \$3500 to assist with their continued education at the post secondary level. All recipients have maintained at least a 75% academic average, are enrolled in a 4 year post-secondary institution, are members of the GAO and are actively involved in the game of golf.

### District Coordinators Report

The District Coordinators Committee is made up of two Coordinators from each of the 14 Districts. One of the Coordinators is elected to represent the District Coordinators Committee on the Board of Directors. Each District elects its own executive structure and is encouraged to offer a variety of tournaments and programs for both men and women specific to the needs and interests of its members. An indication of the scope of these programs can be seen in the individual District Reports which follow.

The District Executive representatives are responsible for promoting the growth and development of amateur programs within the District while preserving the integrity and tradition of the game. The major responsibilities of the District Coordinators within the District are to establish and maintain a District Executive Committee to coordinate the activities of the District.

District Coordinators meet twice yearly with various Board Members and staff of the GAO to learn of new and/or pending initiatives which will need to be communicated to member clubs. The districts also use the forum as a way of sharing information on new initiatives which have been implemented or are in the planning stage for the upcoming season.

During the past year the inclusion of a District web page which is updated on a regular basis has been well received. The interactive section of the site has improved the flow of information to the District Coordinators significantly. The site also provides a forum where individual District Coordinators can solicit and receive information from one another on any topic.

For a number of years one of the major challenges facing the District was the recruitment and retention of volunteers willing to take an active role. In an effort to understand the scope of the problem the District Coordinators, Board and staff of the GAO met in the spring of 2005 to prepare a strategic plan for the Districts and volunteers of the GAO. One of the key findings of the session indicated a need to provide information and education about the activities and objectives of the GAO to volunteers at the District level. This finding has led to a series of five volunteer information workshops being held at various locations throughout the Province this fall. The interactive design of the workshop was well received. Feedback from those in attendance indicated that they were beneficial, appreciated and worth the time volunteers committed in attending.

The development and growth of men's programs across Districts continues to pose a challenge. Grey Power is one event which showed significant increases in the level of participation across the Province in the past year.

Sincere thanks to Sandy Davidson for the outstanding work she has contributed this year.

### Marketing Report Sponsorship

We purchased new banners and frames, which provided better and more professional recognition for our main sponsors. ### Player Development Report

This past year proved to be very successful for Ontario golfers. Mary Ann Lapointe recorded the biggest news with a victory at the USGA Women's Mid-Amateur Championship, while Richard Scott and Laura Matthews captured the Canadian Men's and Women's Amateurs. Richard Scott was also on the winning NCAA champion Georgia Bulldogs. Some of the other significant achievements by Ontario golfers included J.C. Deacon advancing to the semi-finals of the USGA Men's Amateur, Matt Hill winning the Canadian Juvenile Boys' Championship, Victor Ciesielski taking the Canadian Club Champions title and Patrick Suraj capturing the Canadian Senior Men's Championship.

Those achievements over the past few years indicate that the GAO's Player Development program is reaping some significant rewards. Under the direction of the Player Development Committee, the Player Development Program was managed by the team of Director of Tournaments & Player Development Dave Colling and Tournament & Player Development Coordinators Nadine Foreman and Larry Longo.

### Future Links Golf in Schools

The Golf in Schools program continued to grow in 2005 with the addition of 34 schools. With the assistance of District Coordinators in London, Waterloo and Hamilton, we moved into three new school districts. In the Hamilton District, three schools received the Stick to Golf equipment and a total of 137 children participated.

The London area saw 12 schools join the program and it had 597 students take part. Niagara, which had schools participate in previous years, had six new schools added to its total and those schools taught the program to 212 students. Thirteen schools in the Waterloo School District received the Stick to Golf equipment and 756 students participated.

### Mobile Van Clinics

Kelly Mills, Canadian PGA professional, returned of as the operator of the Future Links Mobile Van Program. From early May to the end of August, Kelly conducted clinics at 82 sites across the province. In total, he held 232 clinics and instructed 5,348 children. While the clinics were held at summer camps, festivals, professional tournaments and public golf courses, the best method to reach the most children was single day visits to a school.

### Coaching and Junior Camps

Ralph Bauer and Dave Woods are both GAO Coaches and RCGA Regional Coaches. This arrangement has worked very well as it has allowed access to National Level Coaching at the Provincial Level. The majority of the top ranked juniors in Ontario are coached by either Ralph or Dave and their students over the past two years have won two Ontario Amateurs, the Tournament of Champions (all divisions) and have been the bulk of the inter-provincial team members.

### Women's Learn to Play Clinics

In 2005, this program (which began as a pilot project with one site in 2004) was expanded across the province. There were an initial five sites selected, however, due to lack of funds for advertising, two sites were cancelled. The individuals who had signed up were transferred to other locations so no one was turned away by canceling the clinics. The sites for 2005 were: Angus Glen, Markham; Cambridge GC, Cambridge; Sunningdale GC, London. A grant received in September has allowed us to schedule an additional five clinics with the resources to purchase equipment so that the program may be run indoors.

### ClubLink Tour

The ClubLink Tour was once again a highlight on the summer schedules of the top 24 bantam boys and top 6 bantam girls from the 2004 Bantam championships. The tour stopped at four ClubLink golf courses throughout the summer. This year, 100% of the tee times were used.

### Ontario Cup

The second annual Ontario Cup was hosted by The Ridge at Manitou Golf Club and it featured 16 players (8 boys, 8 girls) from across the province. The players qualified through their play in the Junior/Juvenile Boys' and Girls' Championships as well as the 2005 Bantam Championships.

### Inaugural International Junior Four Ball Championship

The GAO sent a team to the Inaugural International Junior Four Ball Championship in Savannah, Georgia. Ralph Bauer accompanied Matt Graham (Junior Boys' champ) and Michael Oudyk (Junior Boys' Match Play champ). They finished 22nd of 30 teams from across North America.

### MSAF - Marlene Streit Awards Fund

The GAO continued its support of the MSAF by managing the fund and coordinating the award recipients for both the Western Junior and the Ruth Eller Cup. For both events, the GAO planned travel, ordered clothing and coordinated captains for the teams.

### Western Junior

The MSAF Committee sent five girls to the Western Junior in Granger, Indiana. The team was: Anita Gahir (ON), Lisa Maunu (ON), Stephanie Simich (ON), Ashley Smith (AB), and Lindsay Caljouw (BC) and non-playing captain Cathy Sherk. The trip was a success with Anita winning the qualifying round to advance to the Championship flight along with Ashley and Lindsay winning the A Flight overall.

### Ruth Eller Cup

The annual Ruth Eller Cup was held in Tennessee this year. The team was led by Susan Wickware, and included team members Lisa Maunu (ON), Stephanie Simich (ON), Ashley Smith (AB), and Lindsay Caljouw (BC). Team Canada was narrowly defeated by Team Tennessee 4 ½ points to 3 ½ points in the Four-Ball, Foursome and Singles match play.

### Handicap & Course Rating Report

As of December 2005, 152 members/staff of 81 clubs in Ontario have been certified as Handicap Officials. This was achieved through 12 Handicap Seminars hosted at clubs across the province. During the last three years the staff of the GAO, with assistance from this committee, has successfully certified over 500 officials from 275 clubs. Handicap Information Seminars were conducted at several clubs to increase general awareness of the Handicap Manual and the role of the GAO.

Handicap Summits were also continued in some districts. This enabled Handicap Officials an opportunity to present Handicap issues from their respective clubs and seek resolution or direction through shared ideas and successes.

The RCGA and GAO have issued a Club Handicap Licensing Program to ensure that all Member Clubs comply with the requirements of the RCGA Handicap System in order to legally issue RCGA Handicap Factors. The GAO staff and this committee have been active in communicating the program to members and member clubs, distributing and collecting signed agreements and conducting Handicap Education Seminars for member clubs.

### Course Rating Training

Three Regional Course Rating Seminars were conducted across the province, in London, Kingston and Sudbury to recruit and train new or inexperienced course raters. Local team leaders were of great assistance in the preparations for the seminar and recruitment of volunteers. The local team leaders were responsible for follow up and direct involvement of participants in "on course" rating experiences in order to identify good candidates for their rating teams and develop future team leaders.

With the publication of a new Rating Guide for 2006, a two-day seminar will be held at Glenway C.C. in the spring, for Team Leaders and experienced course raters.

### Function of Course Rating Teams

Through a focus of this committee at course rating seminars and the efforts of individual team leaders, the sharing of relevant data between rating teams for a district has become both commonplace and beneficial to the process. Course raters have been trained to rate courses for either men or women. The same rating team has rated golf courses for both men's ratings and women's ratings. This has expedited the process for golf clubs and broadened the experience and capability of individual raters.

### The Role of District Coordinators

District Coordinators have assisted in the promotion of Handicap Certification Seminars and served as a resource to Team Leaders. The role of the District Coordinator in general is being reviewed at the Board level.

Not only did they officiate at all the qualifying events, district tournaments and the 27 provincial championships, we also assisted many other organizations. We are constantly in need of rules officials and anyone interested in becoming an official should contact their District Coordinator or the GAO office. The RCGA Level 1 Rules Education CD can be obtained through the RCGA, the GAO or may be at your club. It's part of the "Canadian Golfer Starter Kit". This CD is a must for every golfer.

Pace of Play is an issue that we continue to work on. We achieved some successes this summer but there is still room for improvement. The upcoming season will continue to see us working on speeding up play.

I would like to thank the GAO Tournament staff for all their hard work this past year, our tournaments are the envy of many organizations. A special thank you to all our Rules officials and tournament volunteers who make working GAO events a pleasure. As Rules Chair I had the opportunity to travel from one end of the province to the other and have seen a lot of great golf and met a lot of wonderful people along the way. I'm leaving with memories that I will cherish forever.

### Public Player Program Report

The Public Player Program was created for those golfers who do not hold an annual membership to a semi-private or private golf facility. These members join the Golf Association of Ontario as an individual or through established Clubs without Real Estate.

In 2005 the Public Player Program experienced significant growth. This year over 3,938 golfers became members of the GAO through this program. Some Public Player members join through the Clubs without Real Estate such as the C.A.W. Golf League, Canadian Caribbean Amateur Golf Association, Ontario Visually Impaired Golfers and the Toronto Executive Women's Golf League to name just a few. This year there were 24 clubs in this category, accounting for more than 930 individual members. These members posted their scores through the Ontario Golf Information Network through their Handicap Chairperson at an established site or through the GAO online handicapping system. Affiliate posting hubs across Ontario were set up at 51 golf clubs and golf retailers. These sites served more than 3000 individual members of the Public Player Program.

New in 2005 was a Public Player Golf League. The participants competed at 5 excellent golf clubs and feedback was very positive. This league will be conducted again in 2006. We wish to extend a special thank you to Ken Murray and his dedicated team of volunteers for putting on these events. We would like to thank the sponsors; Investors Group, Baka Wireless, Ultimate Golf Vacations, Golf Town and Moores for their continuing support of the program and we will continue to strive for ways to build and grow the Public Player Program for the future.

### ONTARIO GOLF HALL OF FAME REPORT

The sixth annual Ontario Golf Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony was held on May 4, 2005 in conjunction with the GAO's Media and Sponsor Day, at Wooden Sticks in Uxbridge, home of the GAO and of the Hall of Fame.

Our president Barbara Allan, welcomed the inductees and their guests and also expressed thanks to the media and sponsors for their continuing support of the organization.

Well known sports broadcaster, Rod Black, was the Master of Ceremonies and introduced our 4 inductees: Mary-Jane Hall, R.Stewart Hamilton, Robert R. Panasik and George MacMillan Frost, who was inducted posthumously.

**Mary-Jane Hall** was inducted in the Administrator - Professional category. She was born in Toronto and has been a role model for woman in golf in Canada. She was the first women Golf Professional in Quebec and the Atlantic Provinces and became the first female Head Golf Professional in Canada in 1980. She was instrumental in establishing a Women's Division in the CPGA and was the first woman to compete in the CPGA National Championship. She has played a key role in mentoring, training and developing golf assistants as well as helping amateur golfers through her leadership in training programs. Her awards include the 1995 Ontario Ladies' PGA award for Leadership and Service and the 1997 CPGA award as Ontario Club Professional of the Year.

**George MacMillan Frost** was inducted in the Builder category. Over the course of his illustrious career "Mac" made an everlasting impression on the game of golf in Ontario. Owner of the original Cedar Brae Golf and Country Club, he also built the new Cedar Brae, Parkview and Brookwood Golf Clubs, Spring Lakes Golf Club and Vespra Hills. He was President and Honorary Life Member of the Canadian Club Managers Association Life member of Ontario and Canadian Golf Superintendents Associations Founding President of the Central Ontario Chapter of the National Golf Course Owners Association, President of the Ontario Golf Association, Governor, Honorary Govenor and Associate Governor of the RCGA and recipient of its Distinguished Service Award. Mr. Frost was also the founding sponsor of the Guelph Turfgrass Research and Information Centre which is named in his honour, the G.M. Frost Building. Mr. Frost passed away in 2005.

**R. Stewart Hamilton** was inducted in the Amateur Golfer category. He was born in Coventry, England. He has won 5 Canadian Mid-Amateur Championships, 2 Canadian Senior Association Championships, 2 Ontario Mid-Amateur Championships, and numerous other competitions beginning with the 1963 Ontario Junior Championship up to the 2001 Ontario Senior Championship. "Stu" has achieved a number of significant accomplishments on the provincial and national stages. He has played on 18 Ontario

Provincial Teams, 3 World Amateur Teams and 9 International Teams. He has been a true ambassador when representing Canada in international competition.

**Robert R. Panasik** was inducted in the Professional Golfer category and was a dominant junior champion, a very strong amateur player and a fine champion as a professional. He represented Canada 3 times in the World Cup of Golf. He won 4 Ontario Junior Championships, 5 CPGA of Ontario Championships, 4 Ontario Hunt Trophies, 2 CPGA Club Professional Championships, 2 CPGA Championships, 1 Canadian Tour Championship, 6 Provincial Open Championships, 3 CPGA Seniors and 2 CPGA Super Seniors Championships. Mr Panasik is the youngest player (15) to make the cut in an Official PGA Tour Event and he qualified for the US Open 10 times, the US PGA Senior Tour in 1994 and the US Senior Open in 2002.

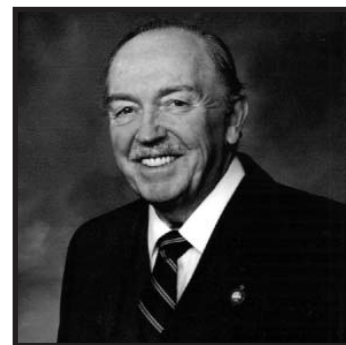

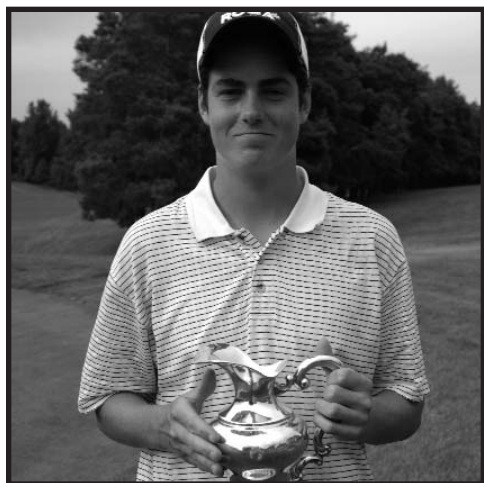

The Golf Association of Ontario would like to congratulate all 2005 National & International Champions. This year the Ontario elite captured five National & two International Amateur Titles.

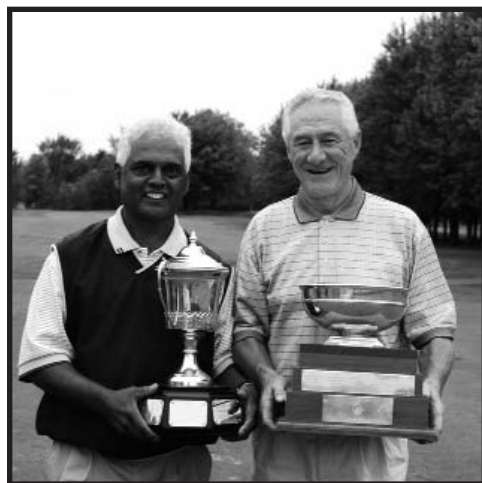

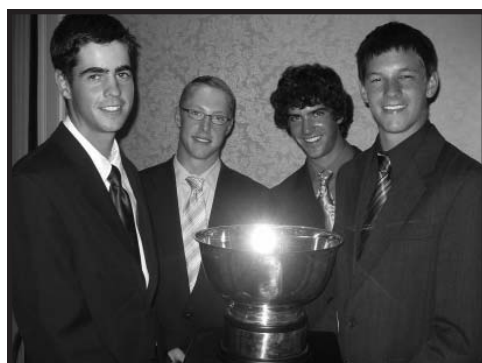

## Craig Revell

(1984 - 2005)

This past year the Golf Association of Ontario and all those associated with golf in Ontario mourned the loss of 20 year old amateur golf star, Craig Revell. Craig lost his battle with bone cancer on Saturday September 24. He was the beloved son of Al Revell and Judy McGowan and cherished role model to his brother Brad.

Craig's talent will be sadly missed by the golfing community he dearly loved. He was touted as one of the top junior golfers the province had ever seen. Throughout his junior career Craig was always among the top golfers in the province. His junior resume included a number of celebrations in provincial championships. In 2001, he claimed the Junior Tournament of Champions and Juvenile Tournament of Champions titles. In 2002, he played his way to an impressive 7 stroke win at the Ontario Junior Championship and was crowned the 2002 top ranked junior boys' golfer. In 2003, he placed third at the Ontario Men's Amateur Championship securing himself a spot on the 2003 Willingdon Cup, while still of junior age.

Building from his successful junior career Craig pursued a promising golf career when he left Kingston in the fall of 2003 to attend Michigan State University on a golf scholarship. As a freshman, he began his collegiate career at MSU with a win at the first event he competed in. He won the Badger Invitational by three strokes to kick start what seemed to be the beginnings of an impressive collegiate career. He continued to lead his Spartans men's golf team through 2003/2004 NCAA season. However, Craig was unfortunately forced to leave school after his freshman year due to his illness.

Craig battled his illness for the next few years but was never too far from the game he loved. He was a regular supporter of his younger brother Brad and was an inspirational presence at GAO events for all those involved.



He represented what the game is all about. As a player he achieved tremendous heights and as a person he demonstrated respect for the game, for the underlying foundations of the game and for all who were involved in the game throughout his career.

In 2005, the GAO developed two initiatives in Craig's honor, the Craig Revell Award and the Craig Revell Scholarship. The Craig Revell Award will recognize the GAO's top ranked junior boy golfer in the province of Ontario. The recipient of this award will represent what Craig achieved as a player of this great game. It is only fitting that the first recipient of this award is Craig's younger brother Brad, who was the top ranked junior boy at the end of the 2005 GAO season.

The Craig Revell Scholarship was created to recognize Craig's success on the golf course, but also he achievements in academics and all facets of life. Craig always realized that achieving academic success was very important in maximizing his career in golf and life.

Craig meant a lot to the GAO and to the individuals - both volunteers and staff - who were involved with his career. He will be truly missed but never forgotten.
