On March 31, 2001 the membership of the Ontario Golf Association (est. 1921) and the Ontario Ladies Golf Association (est. 1926) voted overwhelmingly to amalgamate the two organizations and form a single golf association to be known as the Golf Association of Ontario. The GAO gained official status in November, 2001.

The OGA and the OLGA represented Ontario Golfers for over 75 years. As such, the GAO inherits a long and rich history. With over 420 member clubs and over 115,000 individual members, the GAO is one of the largest golf associations the world.

As the governing body of amateur golf in Ontario, the GAO has an affiliation with the Royal Canadian Golf Association. The RCGA serve a national mandate.

The GAO plays an important role supporting and promoting many aspects of the game, including a provision of services to member clubs and to individual members as well as contributing to the "Good of the Game."

The GAO is a non-profit organization governed by a volunteer Board of Directors and supported by Volunteer Committees and Club Representatives throughout the province. Each member club has the opportunity to designate representatives to work with the GAO and to represent the club's interests within the association. The strength of the GAO lies in its broad range of membership support through Ontario.

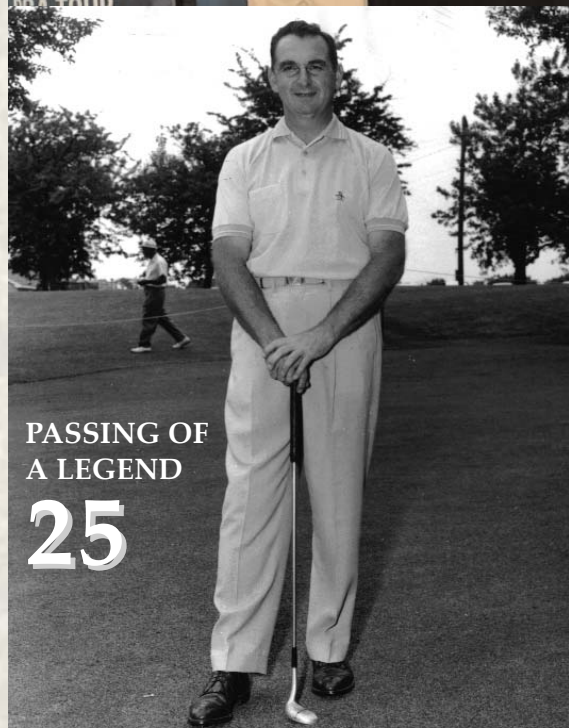

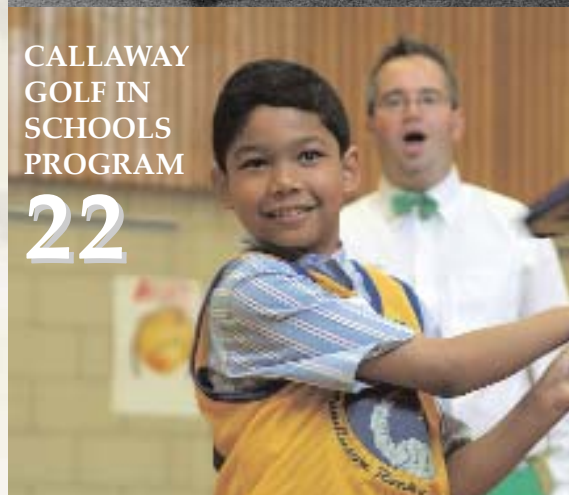

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

What an honour it has been to represent the Golf Association Of Ontario as President for 2007. I have traveled the province and parts of this country for tournaments and meetings with the various golf associations and our related partners. It becomes very apparent that the GAO should indeed be very proud of our leading initiatives and our dedication to continue improving.

In order to continue and expand GAO programming and initiatives the Association relies heavily on corporate support. The GAO has received support from a number of sponsors over the years including Investors Group (for our major Championships), Baka Wireless (for the Public Player Championships), Davey Tree (as an Association partner) Acushnet Canada and Second Skin Garment Company (for our provincial teams).

In 2007, the GAO received additional support from a number of partners including Elco Fine Foods, who added (to their sponsorships of the Men's Better Ball and Men's Champions of Champions) the women's equivalent of these events - Women's 4-Ball and Women's Champion of Champions. Bushnell also increased their contribution to the course rating effort by sponsoring the purchase of GAO Cart Covers. Maple Leaf Foods shifted their support in 2007 to our Women's Learn to Play program and other women's initiatives.

This past year the GAO also secured new agreements with Callaway and ClubLink in support of our Golf in Schools program. These two new additions to the sponsorship portfolio allowed the GAO to enhance the Golf in Schools program.

In addition, Nestle returned as the water sponsor and Westmont Hospitality Group returned as our hotel partner this year which significantly offset tournament costs over the course of the season.

Overall, as the GAO continues to expand and enhance its programs and initiatives, year to year, the corporate community continues to provide the support necessary to do so. I personally thank them all for their support.

Golf has also been finally recognized as a sport in Canada and hence we have received funding from various Provincial Government sources.

The Ministry of Health Promotion provided Base funding which supports to a degree, all programs and the administration of the GAO. Included are Active 2010, Sport Priority Funding and Excellence to support Enhanced Development of Ontario Athletes and Teams specifically related to Canada Summer Games 2009 and ongoing efforts for inclusion in the Ontario Summer Games.

The Ministry of Health Promotion provided funding through Quest for Gold giving Athlete Assistance to work towards Canada Games Team Development.

Rather than list all these initiatives here I encourage you to read each committee's report contained within these pages to enlighten you as to our accomplishments. I will, however, mention a couple of very exciting programs started in 2007.

The Callaway Golf in Schools is one of our newest and most exciting grassroots initiatives brought to elementary schools Province wide. The program consists of four steps; Mr. Knickers and Friends, Stick to Golf, School Cruiser Clinic and Green Grass Field Trips. The ultimate goal is to help foster strong communities through the inherent values and life-skills which form the core of golf. Callaway Golf in Schools will reach a 100 new schools and make lasting impressions on 15,000 students every year.

In 2009 the sport of golf will be included in the Canada Summer Games for the first time. The event will be held in Prince Edward Island and Ontario will be sending a team of 6 golfers - 3 males and 3 females. The Golf Association of Ontario will select this team. The GAO has implemented a 2009 Canada Summer Games Development Program, designed to further increase our chances of winning gold.

I look forward to watching many other great initiatives in the coming years. Ontario was once again well represented at the national championships. Congratulations to our three national champions. Stephanie Sherlock - Canadian Ladies' Champion, Graham Baillargeon - Canadian Junior Boys' Champion and Dave Bunker - Canadian Men's Mid Master Champion.

I would like to offer thanks and congratulations to Dave Mills and the GAO staff. They helped lighten my load tremendously this year and I admire their dedication and effort. Dave has just completed his tenth anniversary as our Executive Director and the GAO has benefited greatly through his leadership.

Finally, I would like to thank my Board of Directors and all the GAO volunteers who give selflessly of their time to preserve, promote and encourage participation in this great game called golf.

SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE REPORT

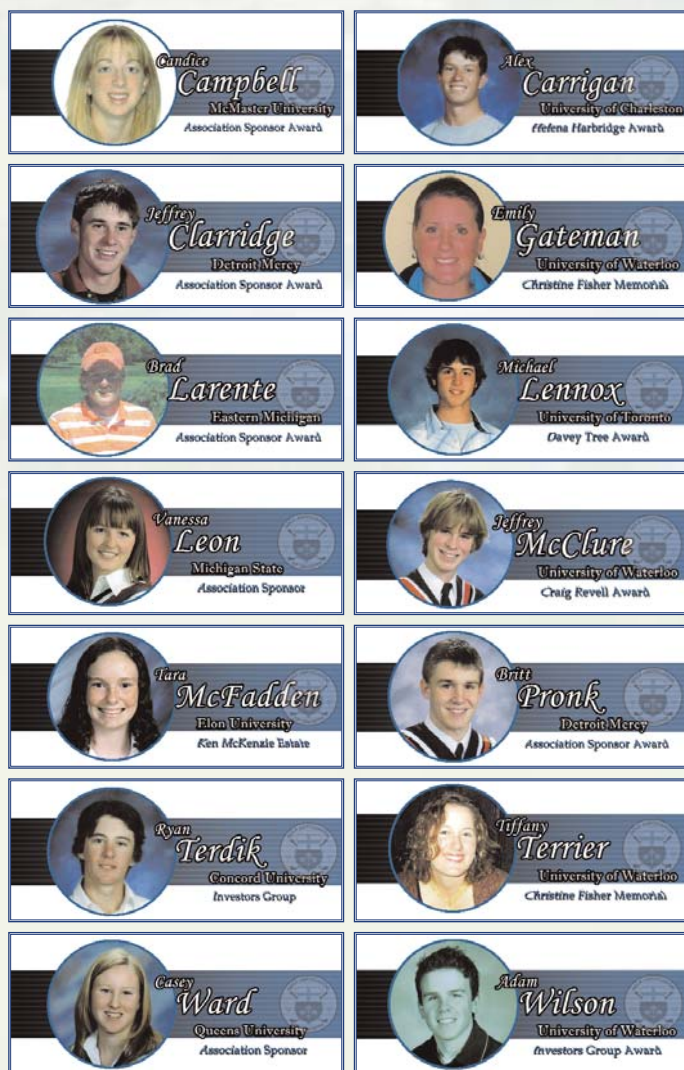

RULES AND COMPETITION

RULES & COMPETITION COMMITTEE REPORT

The 2007 golf season is officially behind us, and staff will barely have time to stop and catch their breath before a new season of competitions is underway across this vast province. This year the GAO conducted 28 championships and 57 qualifying events, none of which would have been possible without the expertise and commitment of our staff and volunteers.

The Committee is especially indebted to the many GAO member clubs who unselfishly gave up their golf courses and club facilities for a morning, a day, or a week so that we could allow our amateur competitors the opportunity to play on some of the finest courses in Ontario.

We continue to receive tremendous support from our tournament sponsors, Investors Group, Baka Wireless, ClubLink, and Beck's Non-Alcoholic Beer. Their support allows the GAO to conduct our championships at the professional level to which our players and members have become accustomed.

In terms of tournaments, 2007 was another year of great success for Ontario golfers. Graham Baillargeon of Mississauga won the Canadian Junior Boys' Championship, with Sarnia's Matt Hill placing second. Stephanie Sherlock continued her fine play by being crowned the winner at the National Women's Amateur Championship. A complete list of winners from this year's Ontario championships can be found in the 2007 yearbook, as well as on our website at www.gao.ca.

As was mentioned in last year's report, 2007 saw the introduction of two changes designed to speed up the pace of play. First, the GAO allowed the use of distance measuring devices (provided that they measured distance only) at all events. Of even greater impact, however, was the introduction of the new GAO Pace of Play Policy at each of our provincial championships. This allowed for a set time for the completion of each nine hole segment of a complete round, plus a small margin to allow for circumstances beyond a group's control, such as the slow play of the group ahead, or time spent waiting for a Rules official to arrive. Once players understood the concept, and realized that the committee meant to stick to the policy, very few penalties needed to be assessed. Results clearly indicate that it is possible to play extremely well and post good scores while still maintaining a reasonable pace on the golf course. Comments received by the committee have been extremely supportive, and the committee is looking at ways to refine the policy as well as broaden its use at a number of our qualifying events next season.

The Blue Golf online entry system continues to serve us well, and the improvements added to the system this year made information and organization that much easier to access. We trust that the players find it equally accessible and easy to use.

The GAO Public Player program continues to grow, and we expect to see refinements in that program over the winter. The format of the George S. Lyons tournament was revised this year, with teams playing at only two courses rather than the original four. This allowed for greater participation at the closing ceremony and dinner, and increased team camaraderie as now two players from each club were paired

together at either of the two courses at Rattlesnake Point.

Given the positive comments received after this year's event, we anticipate a full field in next year's competition, so get your entries in early.

Unfortunately, 2007 was the final year for the Family Classic. Participation has been declining for some time now, despite a number of changes in format designed to enhance interest in the event. The Committee, after a lengthy discussion at the fall meeting, reluctantly chose to drop the Family Classic from the list of 2008 GAO events.

The question of the discrepancy between the age eligibility of GAO events and RCGA events was once again raised. In order to be consistent, the Rules and Competitions Committee voted to adopt the same age eligibility dates as the RCGA, thereby eliminating any confusion for those participating in these competitions.

We are indeed fortunate to have a strong core of veteran Rules officials to oversee our tournaments. A workshop for these officials was held at Bayview Golf and Country Club in April. The meeting was well attended, and information on new decisions was shared. Dave Colling introduced the new Pace of Play policy at that time. Several Level 3 workshops were conducted by the GAO, and a number of new Rules officials were added to our list of volunteers. The RCGA will be conducting a Level 4 workshop at Mississauga in early May 2008, and officials are encouraged to sign up for this 3 day seminar. Participants receiving their Level 3 or Level 4 designation are eligible to receive financial support from the GAO. Contact Larry Longo for further information.

In closing, I would like to take this opportunity to publicly thank the tournament staff for another outstanding season of competitions. Dave Colling, our Director of Tournaments and Player Development, Larry Longo, our Tournament Coordinator, and Sandy Davidson, Volunteer Coordinator, are to be commended for the time and energy that they, along with our many interns, put into these events. Congratulations on another job well done.

PLAYER DEVELOPMENT

PLAYER DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE REPORT

The Golf Association of Ontario continued its growth and expansion of Player Development programming in 2007 with the launching of two new initiatives and significant growth with our staple programs.

2007 saw many impressive performances from some of Ontario's most talented players. The season began by witnessing 15-year-old Rebecca Lee-Bentham claim the Women's Amateur title and then followed that up with a 2nd place finish at the Junior Girls'. Matt Hill overcame a six shot deficit to claim the Junior Tournament of Champions which was then followed by an impressive win at the Ontario Junior Boys'. The GAO is also very proud of Graham Baillargeon and Stephanie Sherlock, who claimed their respective National Championships.

The success of our players and programs is a testament to the focus and dedication the GAO takes with Player Development. We thank Dave, Mike, Dave, Ralph and Ann for their valued support and hard work.

CALLAWAY GOLF IN SCHOOLS

In an effort to increase awareness and impact, the Golf Association of Ontario expanded its Golf in Schools program and launched the new Callaway Golf in Schools program in 2007. This new and exciting grassroots initiative will be brought to elementary schools and communities throughout the Province. The program consists of four steps: Mr. Knickers and Friends, Stick to Golf, School Cruiser Clinics and Green Grass Field Trips. The ultimate goal of the program is to help foster strong communities through the inherent values and life-skills, which form the core of golf. Callaway Golf in Schools will reach a 100 new schools and making last impressions on 15,000 students every year. Other partners include ClubLink, Second Skin the Ontario PGA and the National Golf Course Owners Association.

CN FUTURE LINKS MOBILE VAN CLINICS

Canadian PGA professional David Thain was hired to run the Mobile Van program this spring and summer. David received rave reviews from schools, camps and green grass facilities resulting in a dramatic increase in the number of school-aged children who participated in 2007. From early May through to the end of August, David introduced golf to 8,323 children across the province.

HIGH PERFORMANCE TEAM

The GAO is pleased to welcome Ann Carroll as the newest addition to our coaching team, joining Ralph Bauer and Dave Woods. The wealth of knowledge, experience and coaching strategies has helped produce Ontario golfers at the national and international level of the past few years.

MAPLE LEAF FOODS WOMEN'S LEARN TO PLAY CLINICS

Through the financial support of Maple Leaf Foods-, the Women's Learn-to-Play program increased to 10 clinics and made lasting impressions on over 100 women. The clinics are open to all women who are eager to begin golfing and aren't quite sure where to start. CPGA professionals were on site to provide proper instruction and advice to create a relaxed and fun atmosphere.

CLUBLINK TOUR

The ClubLink Bantam Tour continues to be a very popular event for our young, up-and-coming golfers. Under the leadership of Lorry Moffat, the Tour features 24 boys and 8 girls, selected based on their finish in the previous years Bantam Championships. The Tour was played at four ClubLink golf courses in the GTA

on Sunday afternoons in July and August and including Caledon Woods, Emerald Hills, National Pines and Eagle Ridge.

CANADA SUMMER GAMES

Beginning in 2009 the sport of golf will be included in the 2009 Canada Summer Games. Ontario will be represented by a team of six players - three males and three females - who are 19 years or younger in 2009. This fall, the GAO launched a program to select and develop potential candidates for the 2009 Canada Summer Games Team. This program has received valuable and much appreciated support from the Ministry of Health Promotions Active 2010 program in both Development of Excellence and the Quest for Gold. Our goal for 2009 is to have Ontario win the Canada Summer Games in the sport of golf.

MARKETING & MEMBERSHIP

MARKETING & MEMBERSHIP COMMITTEE REPORT

SPONSORSHIP

In order to continue and expand GAO programming and initiatives the association relies heavily on corporate support. The GAO has received support from a number of sponsors over the years including Investors Group (for our major Championships), Baka Wireless (for the Public Player Championships), Davey Tree (as an Association partner) Acushnet Canada and Second Skin Garment Company (for our provincial teams).

In 2007, the GAO received additional support from a number of partners including Elco Fine Foods, who added (to their sponsorships of the Men's Better Ball and Men's Champions of Champions) the women's equivalent of these events - Women's 4-Ball and Women's Champion of Champions. Bushnell also increased their contribution to the course rating effort by sponsoring the purchase of GAO Cart Covers. Maple Leaf Foods shift their support in 2007 to our Women's Learn to Play program and other women's initiatives.

This past year the GAO also secured new agreements with Callaway and ClubLink in support of our Golf in Schools program. These two new additions to the sponsorship portfolio allowed the GAO to enhance the Golf in Schools program and increase the number of participating schools.

In addition, Nestle returned as the water sponsor and Westmont Hospitality Group return as our hotel partner this year which significantly offset tournament costs over the course of the season.

Overall, as the GAO continues to expand and enhance its programs, year to year, the corporate community continues provide the support necessary to do so.

MARKETING

We have established a relationship with Tee to Green Custom Signage (TTGCS), manufacturers of wholesale, high-quality granite yardage markers and golf course signage. The deal, announced just this past month will see up to 20 per cent (\$5) of individual granite yardage plate sales to member clubs come back to the GAO and be used towards junior development programs.

The program has already been successful in attracting a number of clubs for this year and next. TTGCS have also been successful in expanding the program to other provincial and state association based on the GAO model, which they are giving us tremendous amount of credit for.

WEBSITE & COMMUNICATIONS

We are very pleased with the progress and develop of the new website. It has been very well received by our users as well. The new site which launched on July 19 (as of October 11) has had 130,294 unique visits. Add this figure to the 592,059 unique visits to the old site between January and July we have had 722,353 unique visits for this year. The number of visitors to www.gao.ca as of October 11 has increased 31.3% over the last year.

The 2007 GAO Online Auction was our most successful to date with approximately \$28,000 raised for the Scholarship Program.

We have recently purchased video recording and editing equipment which will be used to help to further enhance the website and communications of the association. We hope to capture our first video footage over the course of the next few months. We will then upload it into the new editing equipment and begin producing edited video for the website and for educational DVDs or CDs.

All Ontario Golf Magazine editorial and advertising deadlines were met and we received excellent coverage of GAO events, programs and initiatives throughout the summer. A number of GAO story and pieces were also used in sections outside the Amateur Report throughout the season.

PRINT/PROMOTIONAL MATERIAL

The Annual Report was completed in early January. We were able to save in the production cost by having completed the design of the project in-house and compiling all information and results in fewer pages than the previous year.

We also updated and reprinted marketing collateral material including membership brochures and information kits along with other necessary print materials in late January. These items were used as promotional tools for the association at the spring golf shows (Hamilton & Toronto) and in our club mailings in the Spring.

CLUB MEMBERSHIP

While clubs with Real Estate showed no significant growth in membership over 2006, clubs without Real Estate exceeded growth expectations by approximately 9% relative to 2006. Clubs without Real Estate account for approximately 1099 individual members. Overall numbers for individual members remain on par with 2006. Plans are underway to market the Public Player program through Public Clubs in 2008.

In 2007 we worked with the NGA in our efforts to grow membership in Northern Ontario and while we continue to move forward in a positive direction with the exception of Idylwyld Golf and Country Club, our efforts did not result in any additional clubs returning to membership.

Membership Information sessions were held for the City of London, London Area Golf Courses, Couchiching GCC and Thunder Bay District Golf Clubs. These sessions continue to be a valuable educational tool on the benefits of membership within the GAO and we remain strong in our commitment to grow membership at the club level in 2008.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

HANDICAP AND COURSE RATING COMMITTEE

Members of the Handicap and Course Rating Committee met during the 2007 season to fulfill committee mandates in the following areas:

HANDICAP CERTIFICATION

Each member club must have a Handicap Committee whose members should have attended a Handicap Certification Seminar. Seven Handicap Certification Seminars were held across the province this year, allowing 113 members from 48 clubs to become certified Handicap Officials. To date, a total of 861 members from 319 clubs have been certified through this process over the past few years.

In late September of this year, GAO member clubs migrated to the online RCGA Handicap Network. To date, 398 of the 422 member clubs have signed and returned the RCGA License Agreement, ensuring compliance with the RCGA Handicap System and enabling the issuance of valid RCGA Handicap Factors to their members.

COURSE RATING TEAMS

At this time, virtually all rating teams in all districts are rating for both Men's and Women's ratings when they visit a club. This has resulted in greater efficiency for the raters and better consistency in their ratings, with less disruption for the clubs. Many course rating teams are now comprised of both male and female raters.

A team of four experienced raters represented the GAO at the USGA Calibration Seminar in Orlando in January 2007.

COURSE RATING TRAINING

Seminars were held in Listowel (August) and Goderich (October) to train new course raters. As well, a new course rating team was recruited for the Waterloo District and training of that team will begin in April 2008.

The USGA will be issuing a new Course Rating Guide for the years 2008 and beyond, so the focus of training in early 2008 will be on the implementation of the new Guide for all raters.

On behalf of the GAO, I extend commendation and appreciation to my rating colleagues who willingly committed their time, expertise and energy to further the work of the committee.

PUBLIC PLAYER PROGRAM

The Public Player Program enjoyed substantial growth in 2007 - approximately 35% over 2006. This can be directly attributed to the change in membership fees from \$49.95 to \$25.00 as well as additional promotion of the program through our website, advertising and attendance at golf shows throughout the Province.

Late in the season, we introduced the RCGA Network to our Public Player Members. Many of these members have now accessed the new system and while reaction is varied, the added features such as the option of entering scores utilizing the new Game Tracker which enables them to enter their hole by hole scores, putts per round, putts per green, fairway hits, etc. seem to be well received. We conducted our Public Player Survey online for 2007 and response was excellent. The survey indicated that 80% of respondents enter 75% of their scores online. We appreciate people taking the time to complete these surveys for us as they continue to be a valuable tool for future development of events and programs.

We'd like to again extend our thanks to program sponsors Investors Group, Baka Wireless and Ultimate Golf Vacations for their ongoing support of our program. We look forward with excitement to the 2008 season as we continue to grow and enhance the program.

PUBLIC PLAYER CHAMPIONSHIP

Raymond Oh of Richmond Hill shot a final round one-over par 72 to capture the Baka Wireless Men's Public Player Championship at Mill Run Golf and Country Club.

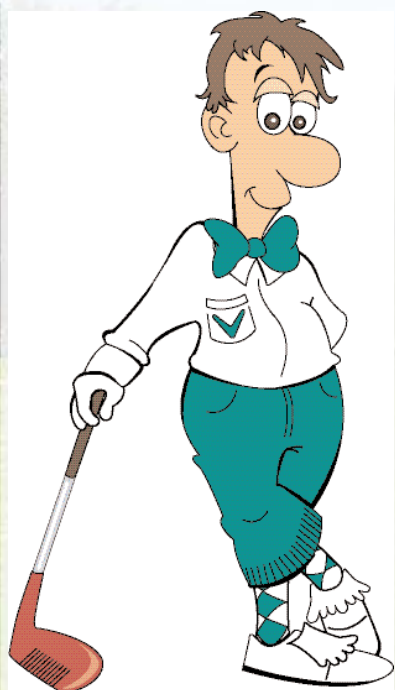

CALLAWAY GOLF IN SCHOOLS

GAO, Callaway Launch First Ever Elementary School Golf Program

In 2007, the Golf Association of Ontario and Callaway Golf announced a partnership to launch the Callaway Golf in Schools program. The four step program is a grassroots initiative that will see golf incorporated into the elementary school curriculum throughout the province of Ontario for the first time.



Callaway Golf in Schools aims to expose, foster and sustain a long-term presence of the sport in elementary schools and communities to encourage Ontario youth to lead an active life. It is also designed to ensure that all elementary school students have a positive golf course experience before they reach high school. Beginning in September of 2007, the program expects to reach 100 new schools and make lasting impressions on 15,000 students across Ontario each year.

Callaway Golf in Schools also incorporates life-skills and values such as honesty, fair play, and respect, lessons that not only aid in achieving everyday success, but also form the foundation of the spirit of golf.

Specific curriculums have been assembled with four progressive grade divisions. Students from junior kindergarten to grade five will experience an introduction

to golf from Mr. Knickers and Friends during the initial stage of the program. This presentation is fully engaging as the children interact with the characters developed specifically for this unique program.

The second stage of the Callaway Golf in Schools program, Stick to Golf, is designed to further develop the culture of golf, with programming focused on developing basic golf skills for grades four to six. The third stage of the program consists of a School Cruiser Clinic, geared for grades six, seven, and eight students. This clinic is an introduction to the full golf swing in an outdoor setting.

The final step in the Callaway Golf in Schools program is Green Grass Field Trips. These half-day trips are facilitated in conjunction with the National Golf Course Owners Association (NGCOA) and ClubLink at a local golf course to ensure the students have an actual on-course experience.

At all levels presentations and clinics will be taught by trained CPGA Professionals in Ontario. The program will also provide an opportunity for one teacher from each participating school to attend a National Coaching Certification Program (NCCP) community sport training seminar. This certification seminar is designed by the Coaching Association of Canada and is golf specific, giving teachers a better understanding of golf theory and practical elements of the sport.

The Callaway Golf in Schools program will also 'help kids get on course' after elementary school by offering a number of next step options, whether that be participating in a CN Future Links camp, participating in the GAO's Mobile Van Program, getting a lesson from a CPGA Professional in Ontario, or simply just playing for fun, graduates of this program will be exposed to a game that can keep them active for a lifetime.

"Callaway Golf Canada was very excited to become the leading partner in this program," commented Scott Reid, Managing Director of Callaway Golf Canada. "We are deeply committed to the sport at

the grassroots levels and our goal at Callaway Golf Canada has always been to make every golfer a better golfer. By having so many students exposed to this great sport at an early age, I am confident that their will be many more golfers in Ontario in the near future."

MR. KNICKERS & FRIENDS

MR KNICKERS AND FRIENDS

The first step in the Callaway Golf in Schools program is the start of keeping students like Katie and Evan on the course to life-long activity. *Mr. Knickers & Friends* is a unique interactive presentation focused on Primary grades as a first exposure to golf! Our two dynamic characters, 'Mr. Knickers' and 'Sticky Dave' bring an old game back to life with colour and energy.



The *Mr. Knickers & Friends* presentation comes to a school for an entire school day and acts as the phys-ed curriculum. Typically, *Mr. Knickers & Friends* will reach 125 elementary students in a day, with specific programming from JK to grade 5. The program is taught by trained CPGA Professionals in Ontario who are certified golf instructors and coaches.

The *Mr. Knickers & Friends* team provides all equipment and material for the presentation. The equipment is Snag Golf which uses tennis balls, oversized plastic clubs and Velcro targets to make this presentation fun, safe and memorable!

Students love *Mr. Knickers & Friends* because they are the centre of attention and are fully engaged in all activities. These activities focus on improving gross motor skills through fundamental movements.

STICK TO GOLF

Katie, Evan and their classmates are now in grade 4 and have reached the second step in the Callaway Golf in Schools program, *Stick to Golf*. This step makes it possible for teachers to facilitate various lesson plans at anytime in a classroom or gym setting. Designed to further develop the culture of golf, this programming focuses on junior grades with specific curricula for students in grades 4 through 6.



All participating schools using the *Stick to Golf* scholastic learning system will receive four sets of equipment, each containing junior golf clubs and putters to facilitate chipping and putting. Also provided is a teacher's manual with sections on life-skills activities, a variety of lesson plans, golf terms/phrases, and academic activities.

Learning outcomes include integers (scoring), language (golf terminology), safety precautions, group work dynamics and short game basics (putting & chipping).

A great element of this learning system is that all teachers can successfully implement this program into their classroom. CPGA Professionals in Ontario provide the initial training of teachers in this step of the Callaway Golf in Schools program. This training session is included in the program fee and can take place in a classroom or gym.



SCHOOL CRUISER CLINIC

Katie and Evan have finally reached grade 6 and the third step of Callaway Golf in Schools, the *School Cruiser Clinic*. This clinic is geared for the intermediate grades and is an introduction to the full swing, outdoors in the school yard. Students like Katie and Evan are finally given the opportunity to learn the full swing, with a fun curriculum including unique drills and competitions. This dynamic lesson is designed to sustain the golf culture in elementary schools and ensure that students are ready to move their game to the course.

The School Cruiser Clinics take place in the spring or fall and are taught by CPGA Professionals in Ontario in the school yard.

This step introduces students to the use of junior sized golf clubs and birdieballs. The birdieball is an innovative product that allows golfers to play in their backyards, in parks and of course, in school yards. The birdieball is cylinder shaped, very durable and can curve and spin like a real golf ball. Limited in flight, the ball is safe to use in numerous environments.

Grade 6, 7 and 8 students will learn golf specific exercises, safety awareness and the basic fundamentals of the golf swing.

GREEN GRASS FIELD TRIPS

Katie and Evan have now made their way through to grade 8 and the final step of the Callaway Golf in Schools program. They were introduced to golf by Mr. Knickers & Friends, got hooked on the game with Stick to Golf and got swinging a club with the School Cruiser Clinic. With that experience behind them it is time for them to complete the golf experience with step four of the Callaway Golf in Schools program, Green Grass Field Trips.

Green Grass Field Trips are the final step of the Callaway Golf in Schools program designed for Intermediate students. These half-day trips are facilitated at a local par-3 or regulation golf courses in conjunction with the National Golf Course Owners Association and program sponsor ClubLink. The school is responsible for the transportation of the students to the facility and the Golf Association of Ontario will take care of the rest!

Certified CPGA Professionals in Ontario are involved in every step of the Callaway Golf in Schools program including Green Grass Field Trips. Using the CN Future Links manual, instructors will introduce new skills and fun games that will sustain interest and address improvement

BACK TO THE PGA TOUR

Mills Returns to Golf's Biggest Stage in 2008

So how does this story get into the GAO Annual Report? Well, we at the GAO are always proud of golfers who have come through our system programs and go on to higher levels of success and in this case it just happens to be my son. This doesn't negate the fact that his accomplishments include having won the Ontario Junior Boys' Championship and the Ontario Men's Amateur Championship.

This particular story starts on October 10, 2002 which happens to be two days before Jon was getting married to Megan. We spent that day at the Oakmont Golf and Country Club near Pittsburgh and I have a few recollections of that day in addition to the fact that the course beat me up. Then again most courses are beating me up these days. Fond memories include:

- 1) The caddies suggesting to Jon how he should spend the last few days of being a bachelor.
- 2) The caddies - on hearing me describe the Albino Deer at Bigwin Island stating how they would love to get a chance to "take it down". Something to do with deer hunting being in the family lineage.
- c) Learning that the US Open was coming back to Oakmont in 2007.

So what has this got to do with what happened with Jon this year? Well I can remember setting a personal goal or perhaps it was more of a wish - which I kept to myself - of being at Oakmont in 2007 watching someone I knew quite well playing in the tournament. So you can imagine my excitement to get a call from Jon this past May on the day of final qualifying for the US Open to let me know that "we were going to Oakmont."

Up until that point the season on the Nationwide Tour was going reasonably well. Nothing real exciting, nothing real bad, but kind of hanging in the top 40 or 50 which would get you back on the tour the next year but wouldn't guarantee a move back to the PGA Tour. At Oakmont, Jon was one of about twelve players who missed the cut by 1 shot when Angel Cabrera - the eventual winner - birdied his last hole of the 2nd round. The immediate reaction was obviously a lot of disappointment, but I think with a few days to think about it there were a lot of positives taken out of the week. Just being there, considering about 8000 to 9000 enter the qualifying was a step in the right direction. Shooting 73 in round 1 on a course that many

consider one of the most difficult anywhere was another and being real close to playing on the weekend reinforced that progress was being made.

After that week Jon's performance for the rest of the year on the Nationwide Tour went to a new level, including a win at Boise, finishing #4 on the Money List, leading the tour with 9 Top 10 finishes, 2nd on the tour in All Around Rankings, 3rd on the tour in Scoring Average and very respectable stats in just about every category. The reward for all this was a return visit to the PGA Tour for 2008 and forcing his old man to start planning a few trips.

Given that Jon finished 4th on the Nationwide Tour in 2005 - same as this year - and then had a tough year on the PGA Tour in 2006, what is different looking to the future? Well, obviously there are no guarantees but someone once said that "experience means that the next time around a lot of the new things that you had to deal with are no longer new." And I think for the majority of individuals who get to the PGA Tour for the first time it really is a totally new experience. Whether it be dealing with the crowds - the "zoo" at the 16th hole of Phoenix for example - the fact that most of the courses are new, playing in events that use 3 courses (Bob Hope for example) and having 1 ½ days to see all of them for the first time or just standing on the range besides people like Tiger, Ernie and the others who are the top ranked golfers in the world it is all new and can be quite daunting. So that initial experience has been dealt with and will be less of a factor the second time around.

The other big change that is obvious to me is that even though Jon finished 4th on the Nationwide Tour in both 2005 and 2007 his game today is much different in terms of consistency in all facets and in terms of his management of what is going on out there. Again part of this is experience but I think it also reflects lots of practice, working with Coach Dave Woods and recognition that to get to the top takes a very serious commitment.

I am wondering how to get a fishing story into this and I don't see any obvious connection, other than a recent fishing trip reinforced the fact that Jon is very competitive, but also the fact that he should stick to golf. He didn't take it too well when his brother Jeff and I both pulled in Trophy Trout at the Yellow Creek Trout Club in Pennsylvania this past November and he was skunked.

So on to 2008 and we will see what happens.

A LEGENDARY GOLFER

Nick Weslock 1927 - 2007

Canadian golfing champion Ada Mackenzie once said: "Some people are old at forty, but others are not at eighty." Nick Weslock was the latter breed of individuals. One of Canada's all-time greatest amateur golfer's, Weslock was still beating the pros well into his fifties and could still be found swinging a club well past his eighth decade. In fact, his amateur record was so superb and his stamina so formidable that the senior golfing community shuddered when he became eligible to compete in senior championships.

Using a set of borrowed golf clubs, Weslock won his first title at a Southern Ontario Amateur tournament in 1939 at the age of 21. Over the next three decades, he won eight Ontario and four Canadian amateur titles, and was eleven times the low amateur scorer at the Canadian Open. Weslock considered his greatest accomplishment to be his seven victories at the Ontario Open. As he told Golf Canada in 2000: "Being an amateur and beating all the top pros seven times was really something. It gave me a lot of satisfaction."

Weslock represented Canada numerous times on World Cup, America's Cup, and Commonwealth teams. He was a member of the Ontario Willingdon Cup team an incredible 25 times and received four invitations to participate in the U.S. Masters tournament.

Showing a keen interest in the intricacies of golfing technique, Weslock once said, "You can't play this game just on natural swing ability. You've got to think about it and put everything in place." He always carried a "little black book" in which to compile technical advice he received from the many great players he met on the course. Weslock eventually shared his treasure trove of tips with the world, publishing *Your Golf Bag Pro: Nick Weslock's Little Black Book of Key Golf Secrets* in 1985. He also filmed major tournaments in order to carefully analyze the swing patterns of the pros, collecting more than 7,000 feet of edited footage over the years.

In 1968, it appeared as though Weslock's career was over. A gall bladder ailment, which nearly took his life, as well as a serious hernia operation, cast a dark shadow on his athletic future. A physical conditioning program and a rigid diet, however, soon launched him back into competition, and, between 1969 and 1970, he won two Ontario Amateur titles, two Ontario Seniors titles, and one Ontario Open title. In this last tournament, he dazzled spectators with a final 22-foot putt to secure a one-stroke victory. As his pro victim Phil Giroux said, "I didn't know Superman was over here today."

Weslock proved his superhuman skills once more in 1973 when, just a few months after undergoing hip replacement surgery, he was back on the course swinging 12 under par. He continued to play well into his eighties, claiming eleven Ontario and four Canadian Senior titles. According to Weslock, it was his love for the sport that was the key to his success: "I'm convinced you have to have an affinity for the game. That's what made us winners, and that's why we'll never stop playing."

An engineer by profession, Weslock never left golf's amateur ranks, but despite having to balance both business and sporting careers, his accomplishments were plentiful and his competitive results outstanding. For his superb record on the course, he was inducted into the Royal Canadian Golf Association Hall of Fame in 1972.

Nick Weslock had one of the most outstanding amateur careers in the history of golf in Canada. His accomplishments are outstanding and include the following:

1944 - 1970 - Eight Ontario Amateur Golf titles
1946 - 1969 - Seven Ontario Open titles
1947 - 1970 - Eleven times Canadian Open low amateur score titles
1957 - 1966 - Four Canadian Amateur Golf titles
1968 - 1982 - Eleven Ontario Senior titles
1973 - 1982 - Four Canadian Senior titles

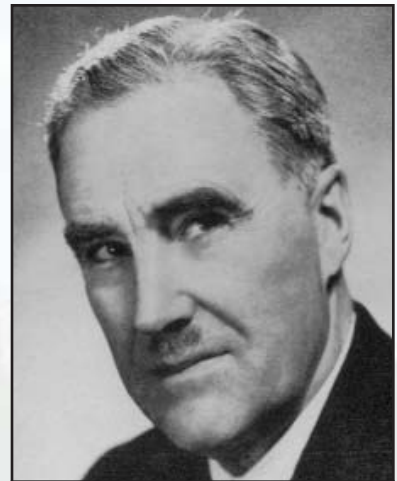

ONTARIO GOLF HALL OF FAME REPORT

The Eighth Annual Ontario Golf Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony was held on May 2, 2007 in conjunction with the GAO's Media and Sponsor Day at Wooden Sticks Golf Club in Uxbridge, home of the GAO and Ontario Golf Hall of Fame.

Our President, Bill Duffield, welcomed inductees and their guests and also expressed thanks to the media and sponsors for their continuing support of the organization.

We'll know sports broadcaster, Dan Pollard, was the Master of Ceremonies and inducted our three inductees; Clinton Robinson, Susanne Lee Hilton, Richard Borthwick.

Clinton E. "Robbie" Robinson was born on April 9, 1907 in St. Amadee, Quebec and passed away on December 29, 1989. Robinson has designed and remodeled more than 140 golf courses throughout Canada as well as the United States and South America. "Robbie" began his career in 1929 with the legendary Stanley Thompson and assisted Thompson on such courses as St. Georges, Banff Springs, Capilano and Cape Breton Highlands. "Robbie" served as director of the RCGA Greens Section for many years and served as American Society of Golf Course Architects President for two separate terms. In 2002, Robinson was inducted into the Canadian Golf Hall of Fame.

Susanne Lee Hilton was born September 14, 1943 in London, Ontario. Hilton was one of the top amateurs in the early 1960's capturing the Ontario Ladies' Junior Championship in 1962 and the Ontario Ladies' Championship in 1962, 1963 and 1965. Hilton made her mark on the national level in 1962 winning the Canadian Ladies' Close Championship, Canadian Ladies' Junior Championship and was also runner-up for Canadian Female Athlete of the Year. In 1988, Hilton achieved Class 'A' CPGA Golf Professional Certification.

Richard Graden Borthwick was born December 9, 1910 and passed away March 1, 1978. A member of the CPGA for fifty one years, Borthwick began his Head Professional career with St. Andrews GC in 1933, and held positions at Cedarbrook and Oakdale Golf Clubs. Borthwick assumed the position of Head Professional at The Hamilton G&CC in 1946 where he served for twenty-eight years. Borthwick captured the 1936 Ontario Open Championship and the 1949 CPGA Championship. Voted in 1938 as the number one CPGA player in Canada by the RCGA, Borthwick was also named a Life Time Member of the CPGA.

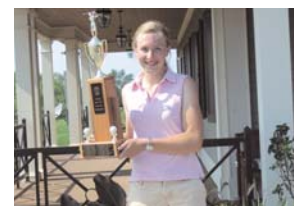

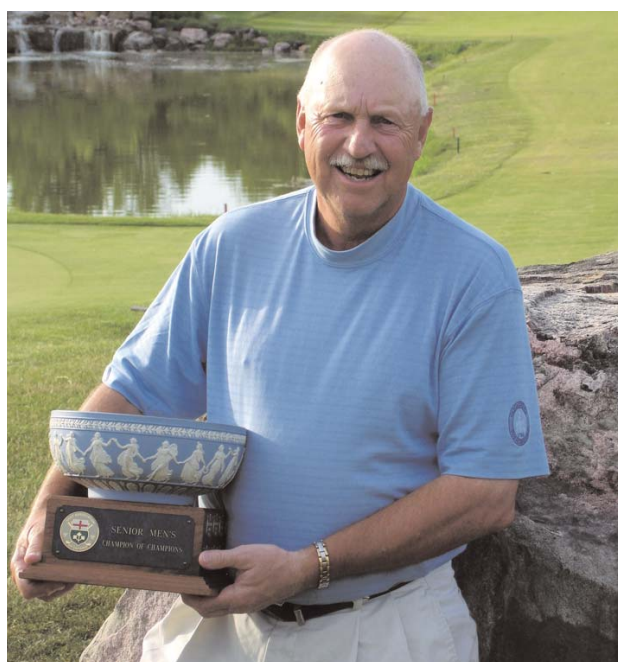

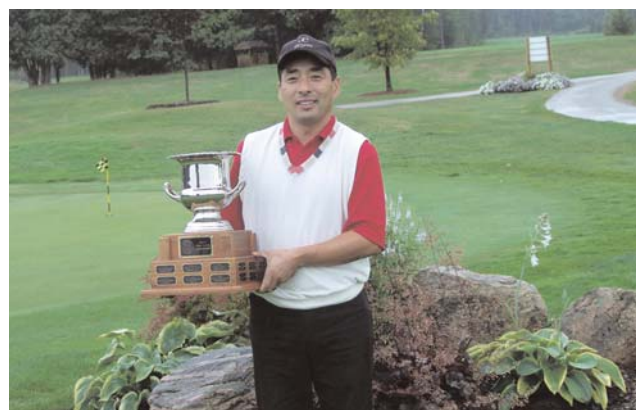
