On March 31, 2001 the membership of the Ontario Golf Association (est. 1921) and the Ontario Ladies' Golf Association (est. 1926) voted overwhelmingly to amalgamate the two organizations and form a single golf association to be known as the Golf Association of Ontario. The GAO gained official status in November, 2001.

The OGA and the OLGA represented Ontario Golfers for over 75 years. As such, the GAO inherits a long and rich history. With over 420 member clubs and over 120,000 individual members, the GAO is one of the largest golf associations the world.

As the governing body of amateur golf in Ontario, the GAO has an affiliation with the Royal Canadian Golf Association. The RCGA serve a national mandate. The GAO plays an important role supporting and promoting many aspects of the game, including a provision of services to member clubs and to individual members as well as contributing to the "Good of the Game."

The GAO is a non-profit organization governed by a volunteer Board of Directors and supported by Volunteer Committees and Club Representatives throughout the province. Each member club has the opportunity to designate representatives to work with the GAO and to represent the club's interests within the association. The strength of the GAO lies in its broad range of membership support through Ontario.

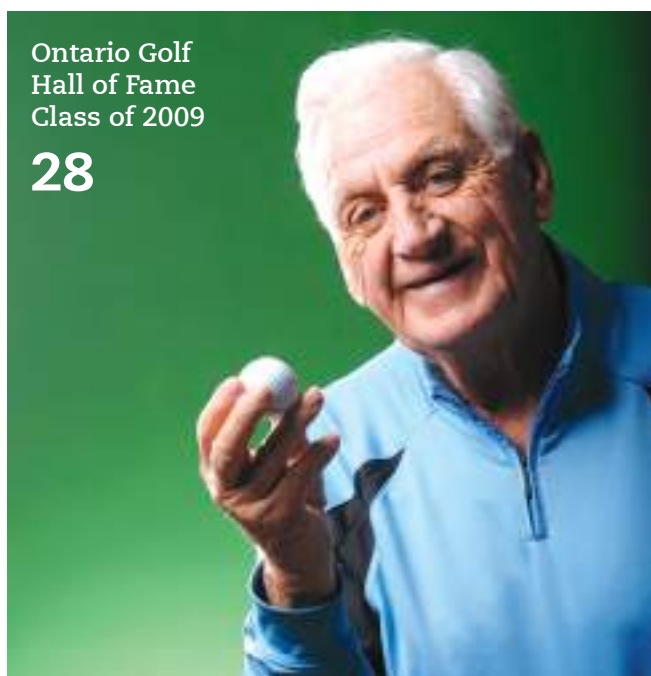

President's Report

2009 was a memorable year for the Golf Association of Ontario. In that time, I have had the privilege and distinct honour of representing the GAO as President. It has afforded me the opportunity to view first-hand the impact that our programs and initiatives are having right across the province. It is once again quite apparent that the GAO should be very proud of its progressive leadership and commitment to growing our sport.

This past year, the GAO Board of Directors, staff and dedicated volunteers delivered another successful season, overcoming the stiff challenges of a tough economic climate. Core GAO programming, such as provincial championships and the Public Player program, saw steady numbers compared to 2008 while grassroots and high performance development programs continued to expand.

A great deal of our continued success stems from the support that the Association receives from our corporate sponsors and partners. Aligning ourselves with these organizations has allowed the GAO to make a significant impact in the golf community, and deliver the highest-quality programming. Our major partner, Investors Group, continues to lend their support to several of our championships and the Hall of Fame ceremony, and has been sponsoring the GAO's amateur golf programs since 2001. Our other valued partners include Baka Wireless, Acushnet Canada, Second Skin, Bushnell, Davey Tree and Ultimate Golf Vacations. I would also like to acknowledge the support of Nestle, who contributed as our water sponsor. Lastly, Callaway Golf Canada has been consistently demonstrating a considerable commitment to our grassroots initiatives, coming on board again in 2009 to launch the Callaway Golf for Kids program. These partners have all contributed to the ongoing success of the GAO, while investing in the future of golf in this province.

Funding sources from the Government of Ontario have been very beneficial in 2009. In June, the GAO was awarded a \$210,000 grant from the Ontario Trillium Foundation to further expand the Golf in Schools and Callaway Golf for Kids programs. This money, allocated over two years, will help the GAO gain that extra reach needed to get our programs into communities and schools right across Ontario. On top of that, the Ministry of Health Promotion provides base funding along with other programs that assist athletes in accordance with the Long Term Player Development model created by the CPGA and RCGA. Support from this funding allowed us to send six golfers to the Canada Summer Games in summer of 2009, and will also assist the Ontario Summer Games program in 2010.

Early in the season, the GAO celebrated its ninth annual Ontario Golf Hall of Fame ceremony, welcoming two new members into the Hall. Northern Ontario golf legend William (Bill) Morland and teaching pioneer George Clifton were welcomed as the class of 2009. We are very proud of these Ontario golfers and their accomplishments. Through the Hall of Fame, we continue to recognize and appreciate Ontario's rich golfing history.

2009 was an outstanding year for our Ontario athletes on the provincial, national and international stage. The impres-

sive results turned out by golfers at all levels illustrated the depth of the talent pool here in Ontario and showcased the success of the GAO's development programs.

Six individual national championship titles were brought home to Ontario – Cam Burke clinched his second-straight Canadian Amateur Championship crown while Mitch Sutton picked up back-to-back Canadian Junior Boys' titles. Former Ontario Amateur champion Dave Bunker captured the Canadian Men's Mid-Amateur and Mid-Master titles for a second year in a row as well. Jennifer Kirby turned heads with her grand-slam season that saw her crowned as the Canadian Women's Amateur and Canadian Junior Girls' champion, adding to her Ontario Women's Amateur and Ontario Junior Girls' wins earlier in the season. Ontario also came out on top in four of the seven inter-provincial team championships; the Men's Amateur, Women's Amateur, Men's Mid-Amateur and Junior Boys' teams all brought home gold medals. Additionally, Stephanie Sherlock topped the RCGA's Order of Merit as Canada's top female amateur golfer for the second year running.

The most memorable performance of 2009 came from former Ontario Junior Boys' champion Matt Hill, who had a dominating season which consisted of a record-smashing eight NCAA victories including the NCAA Division 1 Individual championship title. He has become only the second player in history to win conference, regional and NCAA titles in the same year, matching Tiger Woods' 1996 result. He was also selected to receive the Jack Nicklaus Award as the NCAA Division 1 College Player of the Year, an honour he accepted from The Golden Bear himself. Hill also picked up his first Ontario Amateur Championship title, beating out a highly competitive field by seven strokes. Hill is a native of Bright's Grove, Ontario, also the hometown of Mike Weir, and followed in Weir's footsteps through the GAO ranks all the way to international notoriety.

Building on the success of Ontario's athletes, the GAO's high performance programming underwent a major expansion in 2009. The Association hired Canadian Golf Hall of Fame member Mary Ann Lapointe to spearhead the new high performance initiatives alongside our new Provincial Head Coach, Jon Roy. The Sport Development department has rolled out comprehensive new programs that encompass components like nutrition, fitness, technical coaching, golf skills testing and analysis, mental preparation, and parent education. These new programs will ensure Ontario athletes have access to the best training resources available in order to grow and develop the outstanding talent we have here in the province.

At the grassroots level, 2009 saw the launch of two major new programs targeting young golfers. In May, the RCGA launched its National Golf in Schools program that provides teachers the resources and equipment to include golf in the curriculum for children in grade six and younger. The launch of this program encompasses the schools previously enrolled in Ontario's Golf in Schools program, while expanding the reach into more than 200 schools in 36 school boards across Ontario. This initiative will be supplemented by the GAO's new Callaway Golf for Kids program, which builds off the previous overwhelming success of Callaway Golf in Schools. Encompassing some of the previous elements, Callaway Golf for Kids will reach children outside the classroom in a community setting for the first time. With the creation



of these unique new programs, the GAO expands its reach to the youngest future golfer while providing a positive first experience with the sport.

The 2009 golf season brought another year of exciting provincial championships and qualifiers that were executed at a world-class level. These events provide amateur golfers in Ontario with an outstanding competitive experience while showcasing our beautiful member clubs. The generosity of these clubs and their members allow us to continuously offer excellent venues for our amateur competitors year after year.

In closing, I encourage you to read the committee reports in the following pages to gain further insight into the many developments that came about in 2009. I would like to personally thank all the member clubs, sponsors, and donors that continue to help the GAO grow the sport of golf. To our dedicated volunteers, I am constantly amazed by the exceptional effort put forth to help deliver the many initiatives of the GAO. I extend my sincere gratitude for the countless hours you have spent volunteering, as our programs would be possible without your support.

Lastly, a very special thank you to the GAO staff, Board of Directors, and all of our committees for your tireless effort to make the GAO the outstanding organization that it is today.

Thank you for a wonderful year.

SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE REPORT

In 2009, with the support of its generous sponsors and partners, the GAO awarded \$34,500 to 12 deserving student golfers in Ontario.

This year the deserving recipients received awards between \$2,500 and \$4,000 to assist with their continued education at the post secondary level. All recipients have maintained at least a 75% academic average, are enrolled in a four year post-secondary institution, are members of the GAO and are actively involved in the game of golf.

The GAO has been awarding scholarships to promising young golfers since 1996 and has now awarded nearly \$300,000. The GAO scholarship program is supported by donations from partners including the Estate of Ken McKenzie, Investors Group, Davey Tree, Bushnell, Ultimate Golf Vacations, Acushnet, the Craig Revell Memorial Award Fund, the Helena Harbridge Award Fund and the Christine Fisher Memorial Student Award Fund.

DISTRICT COORDINATORS COMMITTEE REPORT

2009 saw the continued growth of the Intersectional Matches in the Kingston District. Under the guidance of District Coordinator Giles Hurtibese, the number of clubs participating has grown considerably. He reported that there has been interest expressed in other Districts and we look forward to continued growth. In 2008, Hamilton and Niagara began the District Challenge initiative and 2009 saw this double in size as Waterloo and Mississauga Districts also took part. While Waterloo did not field a full team, the other Districts had the full compliment of 16 female and 15 male golfers participating. With Waterloo hosting in 2010, we expect a full field of participants. This one-day event is a great way for golfers from neighbouring Districts to meet and have an enjoyable day of competition.

The District Training Programs that began in Huronia have grown considerably. Kingston, York and Niagara offered the "Learn to Play Better" program early in the golf season and all reports indicate it was well recieved. Huronia, under Elaine Summers' guidance has continued to develop the training programs and have offered the next two levels. The next level will be finalized and be ready for the Districts to use in spring 2010.

It has been a pleasure to have represented the fourteen Districts at the Board level. We are the closest to the grassroots level in our province and must continue to "grow the game". I thank you for the honour and support.

Through the generous support of ClubLink, we continued to conduct the four-event Bantam Tour again this past summer.

At the National level, Ontario golfers captured five of the seven champi-

onships. Jennifer Kirby carted off two national crowns (the Canadian Junior Girls' and the Canadian Women's Amateur) while Dave Bunker scored a come-from-behind victory in the Canadian Men's Mid-Amateur Championship. Mitch Sutton (Canadian Junior Boys') and Cam Burke (Canadian Men's Amateur) each won their respectful title for the second straight year. John Marlow was the runner-up in the Canadian Senior Men's Championship.

In an effort to ensure that we are always meeting the needs of our members, we conducted an online Tournament Survey in the fall. The majority of the feedback was very positive and we identified a few areas that will be 'tweaked' to provide improved service to the membership in 2010.

Rules education remains a major focus for the Committee. We are in constant need of more certified Rules Officials to work our events. Through the 'Brush Up Your Rules' program designed by Jim Furlong and Lee Griffin, we will continue to provide introductory rules education to member golf clubs each spring. Our hope is to spark the interest of some golfers to work their way to become certified at the provincial or national level.

The Tournament Department is planning to unveil a new program for all handicap levels in 2010. A series of eight casual single-day events will be held across the province to provide all GAO members the opportunity to compete in 'fun' net events. Dates and locations for these new events will be announced in the New Year.

In closing, I would like to take this opportunity to thank our tournament staff for all their hard work and countless hours to make our program a success in 2009. Dave Colling, Director of Rules & Competitions, Larry Longo, Tournament Manager, Sandy Davidson, Coordinator of Volunteers, and our Interns (Chris McGrath and Dennis MacGorman) are to be congratulated for all they have done to raise the standard of tournament operations in Ontario.

Sport Development

The Golf Association of Ontario continued its growth and expansion of Sport Development programming in 2009 with significant growth in our core programs.

There were many outstanding performances in 2009 from Ontario's most talented players. The season included six 2009 National Individual Champion titles being brought home to Ontario: Mitch Sutton – Junior Boys, Cam Burke – Men's Amateur, Jennifer Kirby – Junior Girls and Women's Amateur and Dave Bunker – Men's Mid Am and Men's Mid Master. Ontario also had a banner year in the interprovincial team competitions as we captured 4 of the 7 2009 interprovincial team titles: Junior Boys, Men's Amateur, Women's Amateur and Men's Mid Amateur. 2009 also marked one of the most successful NCAA seasons ever by an Ontario player. Matt Hill won a record 11 NCAA Championships in the 2008/2009 College Season including the NCAA Division 1 Individual Championship title. In recognition of his outstanding accomplishments Matt was selected as the recipient of the 2009 Jack Nicklaus Award as the NCAA Division 1 College Player of the Year. Matt also entered the NCAA record books as only the second player ever to win conference, regional and NCAA titles in the same year (Tiger Woods 1996). Jennifer Kirby also had a record season in 2009 as she had the rare feat of capturing the "amateur slam" by winning the Ontario Junior, Ontario Amateur, Canadian Junior and Canadian Amateur in the same season - a feat not accomplished since Sue Hilton in 1962.

The success of our players and programs is a testament to the focus and dedication that the GAO takes with its sport development initiatives. We thank Mike, Mallory, Mary Ann and our coaches Dave, Ralph, Ann, Cathy and Sam for their valued support and hard work.

NATIONAL GOLF IN SCHOOLS

The launch of the RCGA's National Golf in Schools program in May of 2009 provides teachers with the equipment and resources to introduce the sport of golf into their physical education curriculum for grades k-6. The program launch grew the Golf in Schools program in Ontario to a total of 205 schools in 36 school boards across the province. In addition to the National Programs equipment and curriculum, Ontario schools will also receive the Callaway Golf for Kids in school components which complement the National Golf in Schools goals and objectives.

CALLAWAY GOLF FOR KIDS

Building off the overwhelming success of the Callaway Golf in Schools program, the GAO and Callaway Golf Canada launched Callaway Golf for Kids in 2009. The Callaway Golf for Kids program includes all of the components of the original in school program; Mr. Knickers & Friends, Learn to Swing, and Transition Programs, with the addition of a new community sport initiative which will for the first time allow the program to reach kids outside of the classroom. With the addition of the Trillium Grant, providing the GAO program \$210,000 over two years, the GAO aims to increase the number of schools enrolled in the program by an additional 100 per year, increasing its numbers by 200 in 2010 and 2011.

WOMEN'S PROVINCIAL TRAINING PROGRAM

The 2009 season once again brought a high level of interest in the Women's Provincial Training program, held at The Ladies Golf Club of Toronto in late May. There were over 30 applicants for the 16 available spots for the two day camp held on May 23 & 24, 2009. The two day program aimed at women with a 12 handicap or less looking to improve their skill, work with instructors and mentors like Ann Carroll and Mary Ann Lapointe. The program includes sessions on the rules of golf, nutrition, course management, short game testing and trouble shots.

JUNIOR SKILLS COMPETITION

The GAO held a late summer Provincial Skills Challenge at Hawk Ridge G. & C. C.. Players tested their skills in the areas of driving, chipping, putting, and iron play. 100 kids participated in the challenge, providing a wide variety of competition throughout each age division. The 2009 Provincial Skills winners are - Justin Pezzack & Lani Subad - 11 & under, Michael Richards & Julia Hopper - 12 to 14, and Branson Ferrier & Jenna Turgeon - 15 to 18.

CANADA SUMMER GAMES

History was made in August of 2009 at Brudenell River Golf Club in Prince Edward Island as this was the first time that the sport of golf was included in the Canada Summer Games. Team Ontario consisted of a team of 6 golfers – Albin Choi, Patrick Williams, Brandon Ng, Rebecca Lee Bentham, Michelle Lee and Augusta James. Accompanying the team was Coach Ralph Bauer, Manager Ann Carroll and nonplaying captain Mary Ann Lapointe. Ontario brought home the silver medal in the girls' team division and a bronze medal on the Boys' team division. In the individual competition Augusta James captured a silver medal in dramatic fashion as she won a five way playoff for second place honors. Augusta had the honor of being selected out of the 1500 Ontario athletes to carry our provincial flag on the stage at the closing ceremonies for the Summer Games.

MSAF - MARLENE STREIT AWARDS FUND

The GAO is proud of its continued support of the MSAF by managing the fund and coordinating the award recipients. 2008 marked the final year for the Ruth Eller Cup Matches. As a result it was decided to use funds from the MSAF in 2009 to aid our top junior girls in their travel costs to attend top level match play events in the United States. It was a very successful season for our junior girls in 2009 as we had a record number of 5 players to qualify to play in the US Junior Girls Championship and 9 players compete in the Women's Western Junior Championship.

HIGH PERFORMANCE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS

The GAO has vastly improved both the scope and depth of the player development programs in 2009. We have gone from one U19 program of 18 athletes to 5 programs that will involve over 80 athletes in 2009-2010. All the new development programs will include components of technical coaching, nutrition, fitness, mental skills coaching, golf skills testing and analysis, rules of golf education and parent education. The new programs launched in the fall of 2009 are as follows:

Under 24 Team Ontario - Team to be comprised of under 24 aged athletes that are currently enrolled in or recently completed a college/university program and are ranked within the top 20 in the 2009 GAO Men's Amateur or Women's Amateur Order of Merit.

Under 19 Team Ontario High Performance Program of Excellence - Team to be comprised of the top 4 junior boys and 4 junior girls on the 2009 GAO Junior Order of Merit and are not attending a post secondary school.

Under 19 Team Ontario High Performance Developmental Program - Team to be comprised of the top 6 junior boys and 6 junior girls on the 2009 GAO Junior Order of Merit that are not attending a post secondary school and are not named to U19 Program of Excellence.

Under 17 Team Ontario Developmental Program - Team to be comprised of 9 boys and 9 girls that are under 17 athletes and are in the top 50 in the GAO Junior Boy/Junior Girl Order of Merit Rankings and/or played in the 2009 Junior/Juvenile Championship. Also named to this team will be the 2009 Bantam Boys Champion, 2009 Bantam Girls Champion, and the top 5 ranked Boys & Girls on the 2009 Clublink Bantam Tour.

Under 17 Team Ontario Base Program - Open to athletes that played in one of the following: the GAO Bantam Championship, GAO Junior/Juvenile qualifier, placed in the 2009 Clublink Tour Rankings, participated in other recognized junior events

MEMBERSHIP

We approached the start of the 2009 membership year with cautious optimism. While we at the GAO well know the benefits of membership with the GAO and RCGA are significant we also knew the economic slowdown could impact negatively on current membership levels as well as retarding any projected growth. With that in mind we budgeted modestly in the area of growth and concentrated on strengthening our relationships with current members through the introduction of our Ambassador Program in the early spring. As a result of those continued efforts, following are the results.

- Clubs with Real Estate – (10 new clubs)
- Clubs without Real Estate – (5 new groups)
- Clubs terminated – 11 (combination of with and without real estate)
- Individual membership (at Private and Semi Private Clubs) was down 5 % relative to 2008.

GAO and RCGA met with 12 Non Member Clubs to discuss Course Rating/Handicap Trade Mark issues with moderate success. A course visitation strategy is being designed cooperatively with RCGA and will be implemented early in the New Year.

Communication with our member clubs remains a high priority and we conducted a number of surveys with Member Clubs and individuals. Communications with clubs on the pending HST implementation were initiated early in the season and we continue to provide news bulletins and updates on a regular basis. Over 1700 individual member transfers were processed during the 2009 season.

Public Player Program growth remains solid with an approximate 7% increase over 2008. In our efforts to further enhance the membership experience for Public Players, we designed and implemented a process whereby Public Players register online and are activated and able to post scores within a 24 hour period.

Our Volunteer Membership force remains a valuable constant in all program areas. To assist them we designed and launched a new volunteer orientation presentation on the GAO website and implemented a monthly communication newsletter to all volunteers. A Volunteer Recruitment presentation was designed for the Toronto Golf Show and resulted in an increased overall volunteer count to 477 individuals. In addition, we increased our overall Club Representative count to 271 representing 192 clubs.

We are cautious in our projections related to membership growth for 2010 due to the continued economic uncertainty but are optimistic that our efforts combined with the RCGA Course Visitation strategy and will be successful in strengthening our membership numbers. We continue to be committed to providing high quality services and benefits to our members.

GAO MAJOR PICKS

In its first year the Major Picks contest has been a great success. Overall we had over 5500 participants in the contest. With Sandals, Sirius, Woodbine, Mazda and HP all sponsoring the contest there was tremendous prizeing as well as financial contributions. There will be a few changes to the contest which will hopefully enhance the contest for next year. Thanks to all those who participated this year.

SPONSORSHIP

Despite not adding many new partners this year our strategy was to over deliver on the current sponsors and ensure their satisfaction and ultimately their renewal in the years to come. We are very happy with the sponsorship support this season at our provincial championships. All those tournament sponsors were on site and assisted with the execution of the agreements. Their involvement on site and their ability to witness our events will go along way in the renewal process when the time comes.

WEBSITE

Our website continues to be the hub for news and information for Ontario golfers. The increased functionality including live scoring of major championships and the online video player improved user experience and traffic exponentially. The website also provided a new revenue stream for the GAO in 2009 as our online advertising program successfully generated over \$10,000 to support GAO initiatives.

ONLINE AUCTION

Due to the great support this year we have been able to extend the auction for a month which was allowed us to feature more items and thus increase the proceeds and were over \$34,000 gross sales.

Handicap & Course Rating



Members of the Handicap and Course Rating Committee met during the 2009 season to fulfill committee mandates in the following areas:

HANDICAP CERTIFICATION

Each member club must have a Handicap Committee whose members should have attended a Handicap Certification Seminar. We conducted five Handicap Certification seminars allowing 132 members from 67 clubs to become certified Handicap Officials. To date, a total of 1118 members from 335 different golf clubs have been certified through this process over the past several years. In addition to these Handicap Seminars, we also held a Handicap Summit at Hamilton Golf & Country Club which 31 Club Handicap Committee members attended representing 23 golf clubs. The Handicap Summit is a meeting designed to share ideas and information pertaining to administering the RCGA Handicap System at the club level. The session was very well received and will most likely become an annual event.

To date, 414 member clubs have signed and returned the RCGA Handicap License Agreement (HLA). The HLA helps to ensure compliance with the RCGA Handicap System and enables clubs to issue valid RCGA Handicap Factors to their members. Most GAO member clubs (315) are using the RCGA Network (Handicap program) to maintain Handicap Factors for their club.

The Provincial Handicap and Course Rating Committee performed a review and completed a revision to the Handicap and Course Rating Policies and Procedures document. The Committee felt it was important to have this document reflect current Course Rating Team composition, and operations in general related to Handicapping and Course Rating.

COURSE RATING TEAMS AND TRAINING

Virtually all rating teams in all districts are rating tees for both for both men and women when they visit a club. This has resulted in greater efficiency for the raters and better consistency in rating results, with less disruption for the clubs. Many course rating teams are now comprised of both male and female raters.

During the 2009 golf season, 71 clubs were rated, representing a completion rate of 93 percent.

Efforts to recruit and arrange teams in the Northern, Niagara and Owen Sound Districts are well underway. A training session was held in the Northern District after the recruitment of several volunteers with on course practical education taking place. We feel one more session will provide a fully qualified team for the District.

Although strong work had already been provided in 2008 to create a team in Owen Sound, most of the volunteers recruited decided to cease its pursuit. As a result, we were forced to go back to step one and recruit volunteers. We found only a few interested and are working with them on recruiting additional parties in order to run a training session in 2010A similar situation exists for the Niagara District. In terms of operations for 2009, these Districts still had ratings performed by neighboring teams who volunteered to do the work. The nature of our Team Leaders was shown, as several volunteered their team to travel to those Districts and complete the ratings needed.

We saw one Team Leader in the Kingston District retire from duty, but the District is still very strong in leadership with another Team Leader still in place. Plans have already been made for appointing a second Team Leader with a goal of having this in place for 2010.

As we always do, we very much appreciate all Course Rating volunteers who willingly committed their time, expertise and energy to further the work of the Committee and represent the GAO so very well.

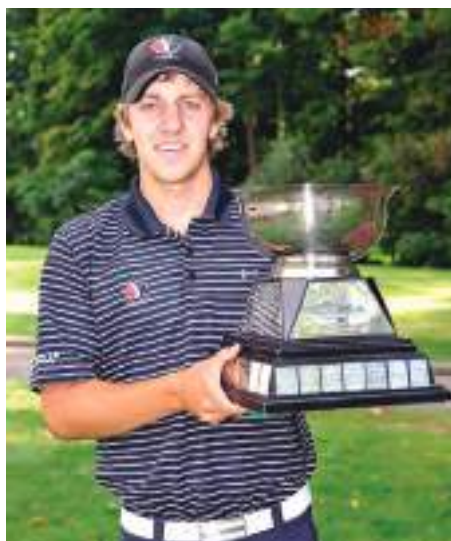

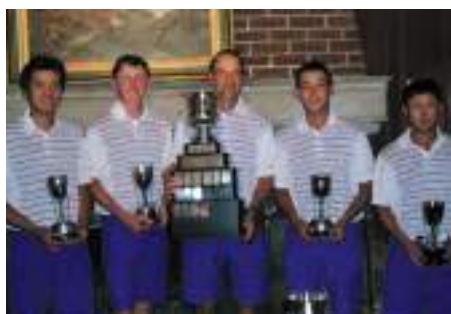

Eighteen year-old Jennifer Kirby dominated Canadian female amateur golf in 2009, completing the amateur "grand slam" and winning every major event she entered. She warmed up her clubs in April at the Future Links Pacific Championship, picking up her first gold medal of the season, and then moved on to the Toronto Star Amateur in June where she topped the field again. But it was her string of wins in July and August that turned heads in the golf community - victories at Ontario's most prestigious events, the Ontario Women's Amateur and the Ontario Junior Girls' Amateur, followed by wins at the Canadian Women's Amateur and Canadian Junior Girls' championship. Such a season hasn't been seen since 1951, when Canadian golf legend Marlene Stewart Streit also managed to capture all four major provincial and national titles.

The Team Canada member also represented Canada in 2009 at the British Women's Amateur and gained an opportunity to play in the CN Canadian Women's Open with the top female golfers in the world.

It's been called the "greatest season ever" in collegiate golf - there's no denying that 2009 was a year to remember for Ontario's Matt Hill. The former Ontario Junior Boys' champion captured eight separate individual NCAA victories in the 2008/2009 season, culminating with his win at the 2009 NCAA Division 1 championship. He is only the second golfer in history to win NCAA conference, regional and national titles in the same year, (the first was Tiger Woods) and by the end of his sophomore year was already halfway to tying Phil Mickelson's record of 16 career collegiate victories.

His success in 2009 earned him the Jack Nicklaus award, presented annually to the top college golfer in the United States, as well as an invitation to play at the AT&T National alongside many of the best professional golfers in the world.

The Team Canada member rose to number two on the World Amateur Golf Rankings in July and also picked up the Ontario Amateur title, beating out the rest of the highly competitive field by a full seven strokes.

Originally from Bright's Grove, Ontario, hometown of Mike Weir, Matt has followed Weir through the GAO ranks to international acclaim.

LEE GRIFFIN

Lee Griffin of Cambridge is the 2009 Volunteer of the Year.

An avid golfer for many years, the Galt Country Club member has been an active volunteer with the GAO since inception in 2001. Lee has taken on several leadership roles, serving as a member of the GAO Board of Directors and Chairperson of the Rules Committee. A Level 4 Certified Rules Official, Lee is an integral part of the GAO when it comes to rules education within the province, having led countless rules seminars at the club, district and provincial level. Her passion for the rules makes her a fixture at competitive golf events throughout the province where she serves as a senior rules official. Lee enjoys the interaction with players that officiating provides, and her knowledge of the game is a key asset for golfers looking for a ruling in a difficult situation.

As retired Physical and Health Education teacher, Lee's teaching proficiency coupled with her love of the game has resulted in the development of a new interactive rules education workshop designed to assist in the recruitment of new rules officials in Ontario. Lee has also been instrumental in encouraging and mentoring GAO members to expand their knowledge of the rules of golf and to seek rules certification. On top of her commitments to the GAO, Lee is also a dedicated volunteer with the RCGA, where she has served as an Associate Governor and Tournament Chair. She has also been a member of the Board of Directors at Galt Country Club, and has been on the organizing committee for a number of amateur events. Lee's continued commitment to excellence in her various roles as a volunteer both on and off the course make her an invaluable part of the GAO. We are honoured to recognize Lee Griffin as the 2009 Golf Association of Ontario Volunteer of the Year.

JUDY WALDRUM

George dedicates countless hours of work and extensive travel to his volunteer position, and has also served as a District Convener and Handicap Chair. George can also be seen volunteering his time as a starter and scorer at GAO championships throughout the summer months.

Also receiving a Distinguished Service Award in 2009 is GAO volunteer Jim Furlong of Waterloo.

Jim is a constant and enthusiastic presence at countless GAO events throughout the year. A volunteer since 2001, Jim has served on the Board of Directors, as the Rules Committee Chair, and as Waterloo District Coordinator. Passionate and knowledgeable about the rules of golf, Jim can be found officiating GAO championships and qualifiers or travelling the province to lead rules clinics and recruit new volunteers. Along with Lee Griffin, Jim helped create the "Brush Up Your Rules" interactive workshops that help educate golfers in an entertaining manner. A member at Conestoga Golf Club, Jim has also been a driving force in implementing junior golf programs throughout the Waterloo District, championing junior clinics and the GAO's Callaway Golf in Schools and Callaway Golf for Kids programs over the years.

Jim's continued dedication to educating golfers and introducing the game to new players combined with his innovative ideas and forward-thinking attitude make him a valuable part of the GAO's volunteer team.

Volunteer Recognition

The GAO recognizes those Directos who contribute their time and hard work over an extended period of time. The Honourary Life Director Award is awarded at the discretion of the Board of Directors, following nominations from our Nominating Committee. Without exception, the recipients of this award have given unselfishly of their time to promote amateur golf and the Golf Association of Ontario and have done so over a long period of time in a variety of ways. In 2009, Bill Duffield was chosen to receive this award.

Bill has been a dedicated GAO volunteer for more than fourteen years. He began by volunteering at regional and provincial tournaments as a starter and scorer. His dedication, passion and superior leadership skills soon became evident as he excelled as a District Coordinator for Waterloo and as a Host Site Coordinator for Provincial and District Qualifiers and Championships.

Bill's volunteer resume continued to grow over the years as he served as a Rules Official, on numerous GAO committees and several years on the GAO Board of Directors. He has also contributed his time on many occasions as the Non Playing Captain of Ontario teams competing at the National Championships. In 2004, the GAO recognized Bill's outstanding accomplishments by awarding him the GAO's Volunteer of the Year Award.

In 2007, his organizational abilities and leadership skills led him to the elected position of President of the GAO. It was during his term of office that the organization was successful in its pursuit of having golf recognized as a sport at the 2009 Canada Summer Games.

Since leaving the Board of Directors of the GAO, Bill has continued his involvement in tournaments with the GAO and is supporting the promotion of amateur golf at the National level as the RCGA "C" Governor appointed by the GAO and as a volunteer in National Championships.

Bill has spent countless hours at tournaments and qualifying events over the years ensuring that each event was a memorable experience for all involved: players, club staff and fellow volunteers. Bill is a tremendous spokesperson and has been instrumental in promoting the mission and values of the Golf Association of Ontario.

In March 2009, Bill also received the Syl Apps Special Achievement Award at the Ontario Sport Awards. This award is presented annually to Ontario volunteers who have contributed to the development of sport across the province.

Bill grew up in Brantford and currently resides in Kitchener with his wife Debbie. A business graduate of Humber College, Duffield spent some time at the University of Guelph before entering the business world. Today, Duffield is retired but continues to keep a business profile with an involvement in a number of different projects.

Ontario Golf Hall of Fame



The Golf Association of Ontario held its annual Ontario Golf Hall of Fame Induction ceremony on May 6th, 2009, where revered teaching professional George Clifton and Northern Ontario golf legend William (Bill) Morland were honoured at Wooden Sticks Golf Club in Uxbridge, Ontario.

Hosted by CTV and TSN sportscaster Rod Black, the ceremony highlighted the achievements of the inductees while celebrating their contributions to golf in Ontario. The event illustrated the broad impact that both inductees have had across the province, Morland as a talented athlete and champion for golf in Northern Ontario, and Clifton as a respected teacher who pioneered new teaching methods to develop many successful golfers.

With a large contingent of friends and family on hand from the North Bay area, Morland delivered an entertaining and insightful acceptance speech that reflected on his long career in the sport. He also spoke fondly of his friendship with Clifton, who passed away in 2000. Grandson Bob Else accepted Clifton's posthumous award as several of Clifton's former students and colleagues looked on. It was a special evening for all in attendance, including current Hall of Fame members Gary Cowan, Marlene Stewart Streit, Dick Grimm, Mary Ann Lapointe, and Kelly Roberts, and also Morland family friend and former Premier of Ontario Mike Harris.



WILLIAM (BILL) MORLAND

Born in 1930 in North Bay, Bill Morland is a multi-talented athlete who decided to focus on golf. In his career, he won more than eighty tournaments and played in the Canadian Open five times. Highlights include victories at the 1946 Juvenile Boys' Championship, the 1965 Ontario Champion of Champions and the Ontario Amateur in 1963. He was also runner-up twice at the Ontario Junior Boys' Championship (1946 and 1948) and at the 1957 Ontario Amateur. He was named to the Ontario Willingdon Cup team on three occasions, and won the Northern Amateur twelve times, the Northern Better Ball seven times, the Northern Senior title seven times as well as countless club championships and invitational.

Morland can be credited with putting the sport on the map in Northern Ontario. He served as a director for the Northern Golf Association (NGA) for over 40 years and represented the NGA within the Ontario Golf Association. He was also on the North Bay Golf Club directorate for many years, serving as President from 1958 through 1960. He was instrumental in growing the game in a number of smaller clubs in the North by bringing quality competition to many of their events. Morland was also responsible for bringing about the inclusion of golfers and golf clubs from remote areas into the NGA at a time when travel to participate in tournaments in Southern Ontario would have been an impossibility for many.

GEORGE CLIFTON

Born in 1917 in England, George Clifton moved to Canada and began his career in golf at Toronto Golf Club 1927, working as a caddy. He became a golf professional in 1930, and landed his first Head Professional position in at Niagara-on-the-Lake Golf Club after serving in WWII. Over his career, Clifton served as Head Pro at Maple Downs, Meadowbrook, and Pine Valley, and as a Teaching Pro at Bayview Golf and Country Club, Nottawasaga and Barrie Country Club.

Clifton's greatest achievement in golf was his ability to teach and inspire his students to improve their game, attracting students from across Canada and internationally. Notably, he pioneered in the use of sequencing photography as a teaching aid, originally using army reconnaissance cameras. Seven of his pupils received scholarships to American schools and two of his female students played on the LPGA Tour.

Throughout his career, Clifton served as Tournament Director for the CPGA and Ontario PGA, and served as Ontario PGA President from 1956 to 1958. He was also honoured with a number of distinctions including the CPGA Honourary Master Professional Award (1974), CPGA Life Member Award (1977), 1991 CPGA Teacher of the Year (co-winner), 1992 Ontario and CPGA Professional of the Year Award, and 1998 CPGA 50 Year Member Award. Clifton passed away in 2000.
