





HANDICAP AND COURSE RATING REPORT

Members of the Handicap and Course Rating Committee met during the 2010 season to fulfill committee mandates in the following areas:

Handicap Certification

Each member club must have a Handicap Committee whose members should have attended a Handicap Certification Seminar. We conducted five Handicap Certification seminars allowing 131 members from 51 clubs to become certified Handicap Officials. To date, a total of 1249 members from 351 different golf clubs have been certified through this process over the past several years. In addition to these Handicap Seminars, we also held a Handicap Summit at The Toronto Hunt Club which 28 Club Handicap Committee members attended representing 21 golf clubs. The Handicap Summit is a meeting designed to share ideas and information pertaining to administering the RCGA Handicap System at the club level. The session was very well received and will most likely become an annual event.

To date, 421 member clubs have signed and returned the RCGA Handicap License Agreement (HLA). The HLA helps to ensure compliance with the RCGA Handicap System and enables clubs to issue valid RCGA Handicap Factors to their members. Most GAO member clubs (316) are using the RCGA Network (Handicap program) to maintain Handicap Factors for their club.

Course Rating Teams and Training

During the 2010 golf season, 74 courses were rated, representing a completion rate of 92 percent.

Concerted recruiting efforts continue in order to complete team set ups in the Northern, Niagara and Owen Sound Districts. A large training session was held at Glenway Country Club for both existing and new raters in the Spring, which helped re-educate existing raters, and educate new ones.

We saw one Team Leader in the Kingston District retire from duty, but the District is still very strong in leadership with another Team Leader still and place.

As we always do, we very much appreciate all Course Rating volunteers who willingly committed their time, expertise and energy to further the work of the Committee and represent the GAO so very well.

The District Challenge between Niagara, Hamilton, Waterloo and Mississauga continues to flourish. The Adult Training Programs provide a friendly training experience for the higher handicap golfer expanded by running in a number of Districts and by introducing a second level for the mid-range handicap golfer.

It was a pleasure for me to chair the District Coordinators Committee. Each District is to be commended for a very successful 2010.



2010 RULES & COMPETITIONS REPORT

Great weather, outstanding host courses, a large group of dedicated and hard-working tournament volunteers and fantastic play by our champions led to another very successful year for the Tournament Program at the GAO.

The already busy tournament schedule increased in number in 2010 with some exciting new events. Golf's inclusion in the Ontario Summer Games resulted in the GAO conducting the 36-hole competition for Juvenile-aged boys and girls at Timberwolf Golf Club in Sudbury. The success of the tournament resulted in golf being named a Core Sport for the next Ontario Summer Games in 2012 in Toronto.

Also added to the tournament calendar in 2010 were seven One-Day Net Events. These fun and friendly competitions were designed to give all GAO members the opportunity to play in GAO-conducted tournaments. Our sincere thanks for making the first year a success goes out to all the GAO members who played in the events, to the GAO member golf courses that hosted the tournaments and to the GAO volunteers. These events were played at The Club at North Halton in Georgetown, Beverly Golf & Country Club in Copetown, Wooden Sticks Golf Club in Uxbridge, Angus Glen Golf Club in Markham, Eagles Nest Golf Club in Maple, National Pines Golf Club in Innisfil and Cutten Club in Guelph.

Despite the continued global economic concerns and the implementation of the HST on July 1st (which added eight per cent to the cost of entries), the GAO showed a slight increase in the number of entries for its championships and qualifiers. Without the hard work and countless hours of support from GAO and club volunteers, we would not be able to continue to operate this vast a tournament program in the short golf season in Ontario.

The GAO is also very fortunate to receive the generous support of a group of sponsors. Without these supporters, we would not be able to deliver the level of quality that has been seen over the past number of years.

Leading the way in amateur sport sponsorship is Investors Group, which is the title sponsor of the Men's and Women's Amateur, the Men's and Women's Mid-Amateur, the Men's and Women's Senior as well as the Ontario Junior Spring Classic, the Ontario Junior Girls' Championship, the Ontario Junior Boys' Championship and the Ontario Junior Boys' Match Play Championship. Our thanks also go out to Baka Wireless, title sponsor of our Public Player Championships.

While we truly appreciate the support of all the member clubs who host our qualifiers and single day events, special thanks must go out to the clubs that hosted multi-day championships in 2010 – Wooden Sticks, Lake Joseph, Donalda, Idylwylde, Oslerbrook, Barcovan, Rivendell, Listowel, Loyalist, the Club at North Halton, Puslinch Lake, Hawk Ridge, Ambassador, Black Diamond and Glendale. Thanks to the continued support of the Clublink Corporation, we were able to conduct the four-event Under 15 Tour for boys and girls again this past summer.

While we continued to deliver the 'Brush Up Your Rules' program at GAO member courses throughout the year to hundreds of members, the Rules Sub-Committee focused its efforts in the area of Rules Education and Training for current and future GAO Rules Officials. Thanks to the hard work of Jim Furlong, Lee Griffin and John Turner, new programs to deliver the Level 3 and 4 Rules of Golf programs were designed and piloted in 2010. These programs will be fully implemented in 2011, which will result in an increase in the number of certified Rules Officials in Ontario over the next few years.

The Rules & Competition Committee extends its most sincere appreciation to these three dedicated individuals for their commitment to Rules Education and Training in the province of Ontario.

This fall, for the second year in a row, we conducted a Tournament Survey, which gave all tournament players a chance to evaluate the GAO's Tournament Program and to provide input into the future of our championships. This important feedback helps the Committee respond to its customers by continuing to upgrade its program.

New for 2011 will be an expansion of the One-Day Net Event program to 12 tournaments and, as part of the GAO's 10th anniversary celebrations, the re-introduction of the Southpaw tournament. The left-handers tournament, which has been dormant since 1970, will be played at Whitevale Golf and Country Club on September 26th.

In closing, I would like to take this opportunity to thank the Rules & Competitions Committee members for their input and support and our tournament staff for their continued dedication to delivering a high quality tournament program. My personal appreciation goes to Dave Colling, Director of Rules & Competitions, Larry Longo, Tournament Manager, Sandy Davidson, Coordinator of Volunteers and our Interns (Dennis MacGorman and Matt Doherty) for their work throughout the year.

Sport Development

It was another banner year for the Golf Association of Ontario and its continued effort to move the sport of golf forward in Ontario including tremendous growth in its core programming.

2010 was marked by significant performances by Ontario's top athletes including five individual National Championships; Richard Jung - Junior Boys', Rebecca Lee-Bentham - Junior Girls', Albin Choi - Men's Amateur, Dave Bunker - Men's Mid-Amateur and Mid-Master and Mary Ann Hayward - Senior Women. The GAO Inter-Provincial Teams also captured five of seven team titles: Women's Amateur, Junior Boys', Junior Girls', Men's Mid-Amateur and Senior Women. Ontario also finished well in International Championships including: (USGA) Jennifer Kirby & Stephanie Sherlock – Women's Am Semi-Finalists, Richard Jung – Junior Am Quarter-finalist, Mary Ann Hayward – Senior Women's Semi-Finalist and (British Ladies) Rebecca-Lee Bentham – Women's Am Semi-Finalist.

The GAO also hosted the Williamson Cup for the first time in 10 years, which was contested at Essex Golf and Country Club in Windsor.

The continued success of our athletes and programs is a testament to the focus and dedication that the GAO takes with its sport development initiatives. We thank Mike, Mallory, Mary Ann, and Jon for their efforts over the last year.

NATIONAL GOLF IN SCHOOLS & CALLAWAY GOLF FOR KIDS

Golf in elementary schools across Ontario continued to grow at a rapid pace including 272 new schools registering in the National Golf In Schools program in 2010.

As part of Callaway Golf For Kids, the Mr. Knickers and Friends program reached over 12,000 students while over 100 youth benefited from Future Champions Clinics. All of this was made possible through the Trillium Foundation and regional support including: Windsor District Junior Golf Academy, Limestone Foundation and Cathy Goodfellow, ClubLink, Golf North, Coppinwood GC, Bruce's Golf Rewards and Mix 97 in Belleville.

CN FUTURE LINKS

2010 was another successful year, as the GAO continues to support CN Future Links and its family of programs.

Contested in late August, the GAO held the Provincial Skills Challenge Final at Ambassador Golf Club in Windsor and the age winners included: Luc Warnock and Hailey Katona – 11 and Under, Matthew Leckie, Blake Hill, Colton Vriesacke and Hollie Carr – 12-14 and Brad Mellon and Jordan Schatz – 15-18.

Also, the Mobile Van program kept rolling with CPGA Professional Gary Price and University of Memphis Graduate Gavin Aldridge, who a introduced over 10,000 youth to the sport over the summer months.

GOLF DEVELOPMENT CENTRES

The GAO is excited about the launch of Golf Development Centres (GDC's) in 2011 which will provide juniors a clear developmental pathway with proper coaching support. GDC's will offer competitive training programs following initiation to the sport at clubs across the Province. All centres will be certified through the GAO.





COACH DEVELOPMENT

The GAO has taken the lead in supporting Ontario golf coaches in partnership with the Ministry and CPGA zones in Ontario. Coaching is an incredibly important piece to athlete development and they are critical to the success of GAO programming at all levels. The coach development program includes: Ontario Golf Coaching Summit – April 11-13th 2011 in Niagara Falls, Ontario, Golf Coaches website www.coaching.gao.ca, and joining coaches as member of the GAO.

ONTARIO SUMMER GAMES

History was once again made this year as golf made it's début at the Ontario Summer Games at Timberwolf GC in Sudbury. The event featured the top 25 boys and 25 girls under the age of 17 in Ontario. At the conclusion of play, six athletes reached the podium. Boys: Tuner Southey-Gordon – Gold Medalist, Matthew Scobie – Silver and Matt Lemay – Bronze.

Girls: Brogan McKinnon – Gold Medalist, Meghan McDougall – Silver and Casey McNeil – Bronze.

As part of the Games, the GAO embarked on a legacy project that included start up of a Golf Development Centre in Sudbury, Future Champions Clinic for local youth and opportunities for local coaches to experience the Games.

CAN-AM MATCHES

Sixteen of Ontario's best junior golfers won the 12th Annual Can-Am Junior Team Matches in Myrtle Beach, South Carolina. The victory marks the third time that Ontario has hoisted the trophy, and the first time that the win has been shared by a team of both male and female athletes. The event is held each year at Wachesaw Plantation Club in Murrells Inlet, SC, and until 2010 was exclusively as a junior boys' event. The top 16 ranked junior golfers (eight boys and eight girls) from the Golf Association of Ontario are matched up against the top 16 juniors from South Carolina.

TEAM ONTARIO DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

The GAO has implemented several new initiatives for the 2011 golf season to further advance the development of high performance athletes in the province. 2011 will see the GAO's High Performance strategy focus on two main athlete development programs; Under 19 and U17 Team Ontario. 
2010 ONTARIO SUMMER GAMES

ONTARIO DEFENDS ADA MACKENZIE TITLE




TEAM ONTARIO VICTORIOUS AT CAN-AM JUNIOR TEAM MATCHES








2010 marked another successful year for Ontario athletes on the national stage, with several golfers from our province earning Canada's most prestigious amateur titles.

Roy Bratty of London is the 2010 Volunteer of the Year.

Roy has been volunteering his time with the GAO for more than ten years in several different capacities; as a Club Representative, GAO Ambassador, District Rules Convener, Player Development Convener, Provincial Rules Official, and London District Coordinator from 2003-2009. As a Level 4 Certified Rules Official, Roy is a familiar face at district, provincial and national events dedicating his time as a Rules Official or Site Coordinator, and can also be found lending his expertise to GAO rules seminars and workshops. On top of his commitments to the GAO, Roy has also been involved with several university and college golf championships, and has developed a special interest in the growth of the game and the development of young golfers. 

Ontario Golf Hall of Fame



The Golf Association of Ontario celebrated the 10th anniversary of the Ontario Golf Hall of Fame on May 5th, 2010 with the induction of 2003 Masters champion Mike Weir.

Hosted by CTV and TSN sportscaster Rod Black, the ceremony highlighted Weir's playing career thus far; from his beginnings at Huron Oaks Golf Club, to his first Ontario Amateur crown, to his thrilling win at the 2003 Masters and beyond. Current Hall of Fame member and sportswriter Lorne Rubenstein was also on hand to share his memories of Weir's ascent to international success.

Weir delivered a video address to the attendees and reflected on the years spent developing his game in Ontario. Weir's father, Rich Weir, accepted the honours on behalf of his son.

The event brought together numerous former inductees, including Rubenstein, Gary Cowan, Marlene Stewart Streit, Stu Hamilton, Warren Sye, Dick Grimm, Kelly Roberts, Kay Helleur, and Mary Ann Hayward.



MIKE WEIR

After honing his skills as a young golfer at Huron Oaks Golf Club in Bright's Grove, Ontario, Mike Weir has catapulted to the forefront of professional golf in Canada with his impressive playing career. At age 16, he captured his first national title with a victory at the 1986 Canadian Juvenile Championship, and followed that up two years later with the Ontario Junior title. He continued to progress with his first Ontario Amateur crown in 1990, and earned a second provincial victory in 1992.

Weir, The Canadian Tour Rookie of the Year (1993), went on to win the BC Tel Pacific Open and the Canadian Masters (1997) as well as the 1998 PGA Tour Q-School. He clinched his first PGA Tour victory in 1999 and has since gone on to win seven more titles including the 2003 Masters Tournament in Augusta, Georgia. In that same year, he was awarded the Lou Marsh Memorial Trophy by Canadian journalists as the outstanding Canadian Athlete of the Year.

Weir's other accomplishments include representing the International Team at the President's Cup (2000, 2003, 2005, 2007) and representing Canada at three World Cups (2000-2003). In 2009, Weir was inducted into the Canadian Golf Hall of Fame and was also invested as a Member of the Order of Canada.

Congratulations to Mike Weir and all of the inductees over the past decade.

We continue to encourage nominations to the Hall of Fame with the appropriate literature available online or from the GAO office. The Ontario Golf Hall of Fame is housed at Wooden Sticks Golf Club and we continue to accept donations to further the undertakings of the Hall.
