Team Ontario

Team Ontario provides training, development, and competitive opportunities for Ontario's top junior golfers. Athletes selected to the program come together throughout the season for a series of camps, performance testing sessions, and competitive experiences that complement and enhance the work they are already doing with their personal coaches and community golf programs.

Eligibility

To be considered for selection to Team Ontario, athletes must:

- Be a member in good standing with Golf Ontario
- Not be subject to any disciplinary process or sanctions by Golf Ontario
- Hold unquestioned amateur status
- Adhere to the Golf Ontario Code of Conduct
- Be a permanent resident of Ontario (primary residence in Ontario with a valid OHIP card)
- Be a Canadian citizen or a Permanent Resident card holder with documentation
- Be under 19 years of age as of August 1, 2026

Objective Selection Criteria

The following objective performance measurables will be considered:

- Scoring average from 2025 competition results
- Scoring differential from 2025 competition results
- Head-to-head results from 2025 competition rounds
- 2025 Ontario Junior Golf Pathway Rankings (U15, U17, and U19 divisions)
- Junior Golf Scoreboard Ranking
- World Amateur Golf Ranking
- Foresight Data (2025 Super Camp)

Subjective Selection Criteria

Selections will also consider the following:

- Work ethic, behaviour (on and off the course), and team compatibility
- Golf Ontario tracking and monitoring evaluations
- Performance trends throughout the season
- Projected ability and athlete's desire to achieve high performance benchmarks
- "Coachability" and openness to feedback

Selection Committee

The Selection Committee consists of three voting members, including the Golf Ontario Head Provincial Coach and two non Golf Ontario staff.
