



2026 Ontario Summer Games
Kitchener, ON
July 31 – August 2, 2026

The Ontario Summer Games began in 1973 in Etobicoke, ON and have continued bi-annually hosting a multitude of events throughout the program. In August 2010, golf made its appearance in the Ontario Summer Games for the first time. As a result of obtaining official 'sport' status from Sport Canada, athletes from across Ontario have the opportunity to play for Gold again in 2026.

The Summer Games are a multi-sport games hosting 20 sporting events providing an exciting opportunity that gives participants, communities, volunteers and everyone a chance to compete and celebrate the growth and excellence of sport in Ontario.

Where:

Competition: Doon Valley Golf Course - 500 Doon Valley Dr, Kitchener, ON N2P 1B4

Format:

54 Holes: Each round held on its own day.

Individual Stroke Play: Top 3 will be awarded Gold, Silver and Bronze for Boys & Girls divisions.

Team Competition: 10 teams to be made up from Ontario Regional Junior Tours.
9 players per team – 6 boys, 3 girls

Tour Eligibility:

To participate, a tour must:

- Be recognized by Golf Ontario as a regional junior tour, as a part of Junior Golf Pathway.
- Be able to field a team of 6 boys, 3 girls, and 2 staff.

Athlete Eligibility:

Entries are open to:

- Members on an Ontario Junior Golf Pathway Regional Junior Tour.
- Male and female amateur golfers must be 18 & under **ON** August 1, 2026.
- Golf Ontario members through a member golf club or the Public Player Program.
- **Have an up-to-date Golf Canada Handicap Index of 36.4** visible on the Golf Canada Score Centre at the time of online registration through the completion of the games.

Fees:

Entry fee for players is **\$165** – that includes: 54 holes of competition, practice round, accommodations (from the night of Jul 31st to checkout on August 2nd), meals, use of practice range, shuttling, tee gift upon registration,

*Accommodations for 2 coaches/team managers will also be covered by the Ontario Summer Games



Qualifying Process:

Each tour will determine and communicate its own selection criteria, which may include standings, qualifying events, or other processes. Tours must submit their final rosters and staff information to Golf Ontario by July 1st.

Tournament Registration:

Team participants, coaches and managers will need to register through the Ontario Summer Games Registration Portal. Additionally, participants will need to register through the Ontario Summer Games Golf Genius Portal as well.
