



2026 Williamson Cup Team Guidelines

Event Details

The Williamson Cup was established in 1964 by A. Fred Williamson, in memory of his father, one of the original founders of the famed Winged Foot Golf Club and a long-time member of the USGA Executive Committee. The event is made up of teams of 4 junior boys (U19) representing 9 organizations from Ontario, Quebec, Pennsylvania, Maryland, and New York.

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to represent Golf Ontario, athletes must:

- Meet all competitor eligibility requirements outlined in the 2026 Williamson Cup guidelines.
- Be under 17 years of age as of August 1, 2026 (born August 2, 2009 or later).
- Be a member in good standing with Golf Ontario and Golf Canada.
- Be a permanent resident of Ontario.
- Compete in the 2026 Ontario Junior Boys' Amateur Championship.

Selection Process

- The top four eligible athletes who competed in the 2026 Ontario Junior Boys' Amateur Championship and are not in the field for the 2026 Canadian Junior Boys' Amateur Championship will be invited.
- If a selected athlete declines their invitation, the next eligible athlete on the leaderboard will be selected.

Fee

Fees for selected players is \$300(plus tax). This includes travel, accommodations, meals, and 54 holes of golf.
